Enlargement of school premises at Alexandra Infant and St Paul's Junior Schools

Notice is given in accordance with section 19(1) of the Education and Inspections Act 2006 that the Royal Borough of Kingston upon Thames and Southwark Diocese intends to make a prescribed alteration to Alexandra Community Infant School, Alexandra Road, Kingston upon Thames, KT2 6SE and St Paul's Church of England Junior School, Princes Road, Kingston upon Thames, KT2 6AZ from 1 September 2011.

The Local Authority intends to increase the capacity of Alexandra Infant School by 90 places in order to provide the physical capacity for an additional form of entry to be accommodated from the start of the 2011/12 academic year. The current capacity of the school is 180 and the proposed capacity will be 270.

The Local Authority and the Governing Body of St Paul's C of E Junior School intends to increase the capacity of St Paul's Junior School by 120 places in order to provide the physical capacity for an additional form of entry to be accommodated from the start of the 2011/12 academic year. The current capacity of the school is 240 and the proposed capacity will be 360.

The current number of pupils registered at the infants school is 233 and junior school is 239. The current admission number for both schools is 60 and the proposed admission number will be 90.

Explanatory Notes:

1. Following a substantial rise in the birth rate and subsequent increase in the number of resident children, the Local Authority has embarked upon a strategy to permanently increase the number of primary school places in the Borough.
2. The current roll of 233 at Alexandra Infant School includes two additional classes admitted in September 2008 and 2009 to provide a temporary increase in the number of places in

Year R at the school. This first additional cohort will transfer into St Paul's C of E Junior School in September 2011.

3. Following the determination of this proposal, an application will be made in accordance with section 1.21 of the School Admissions Code to the Office of the Schools Adjudicator for an increase in both schools' Published Admission Numbers for September 2011.
