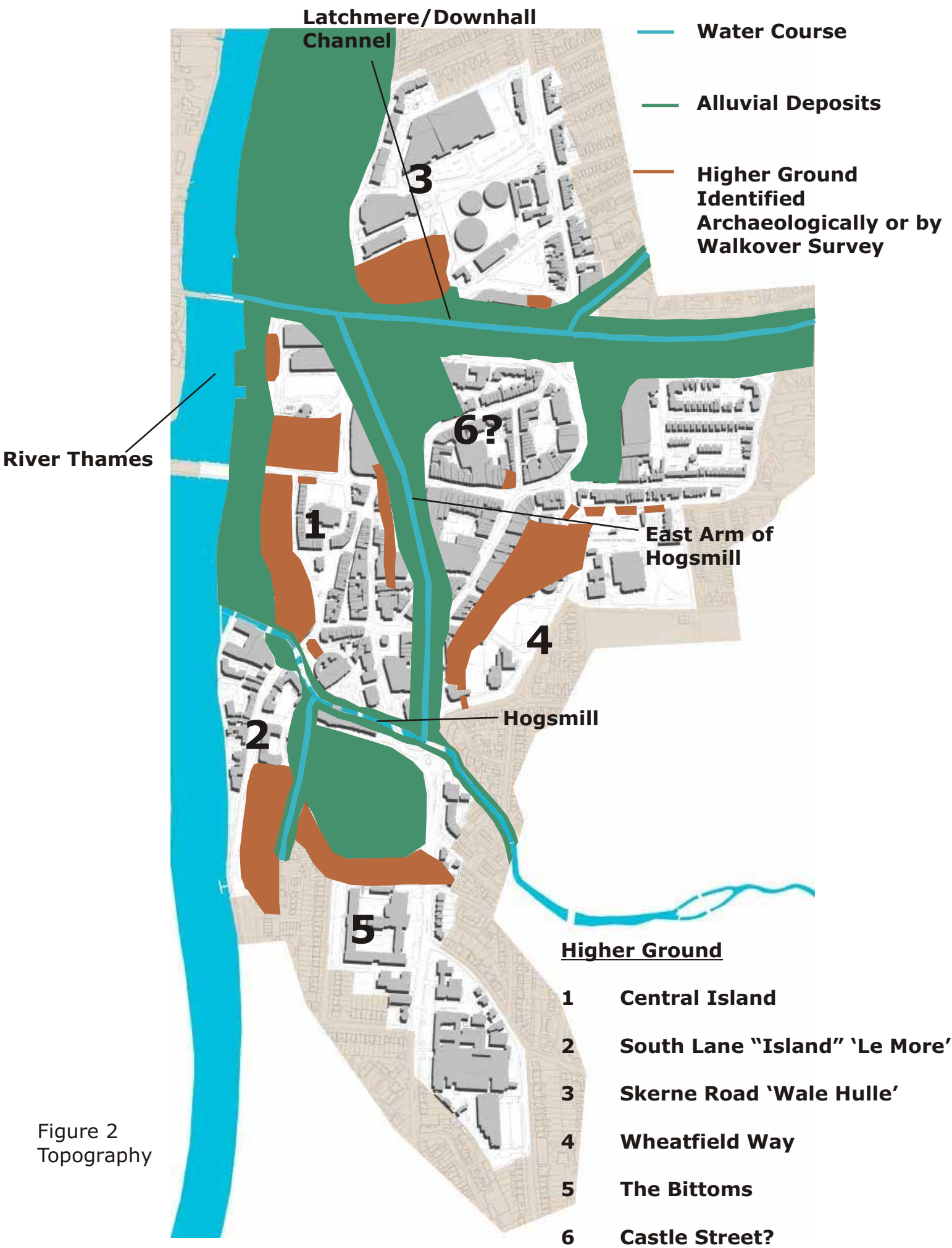

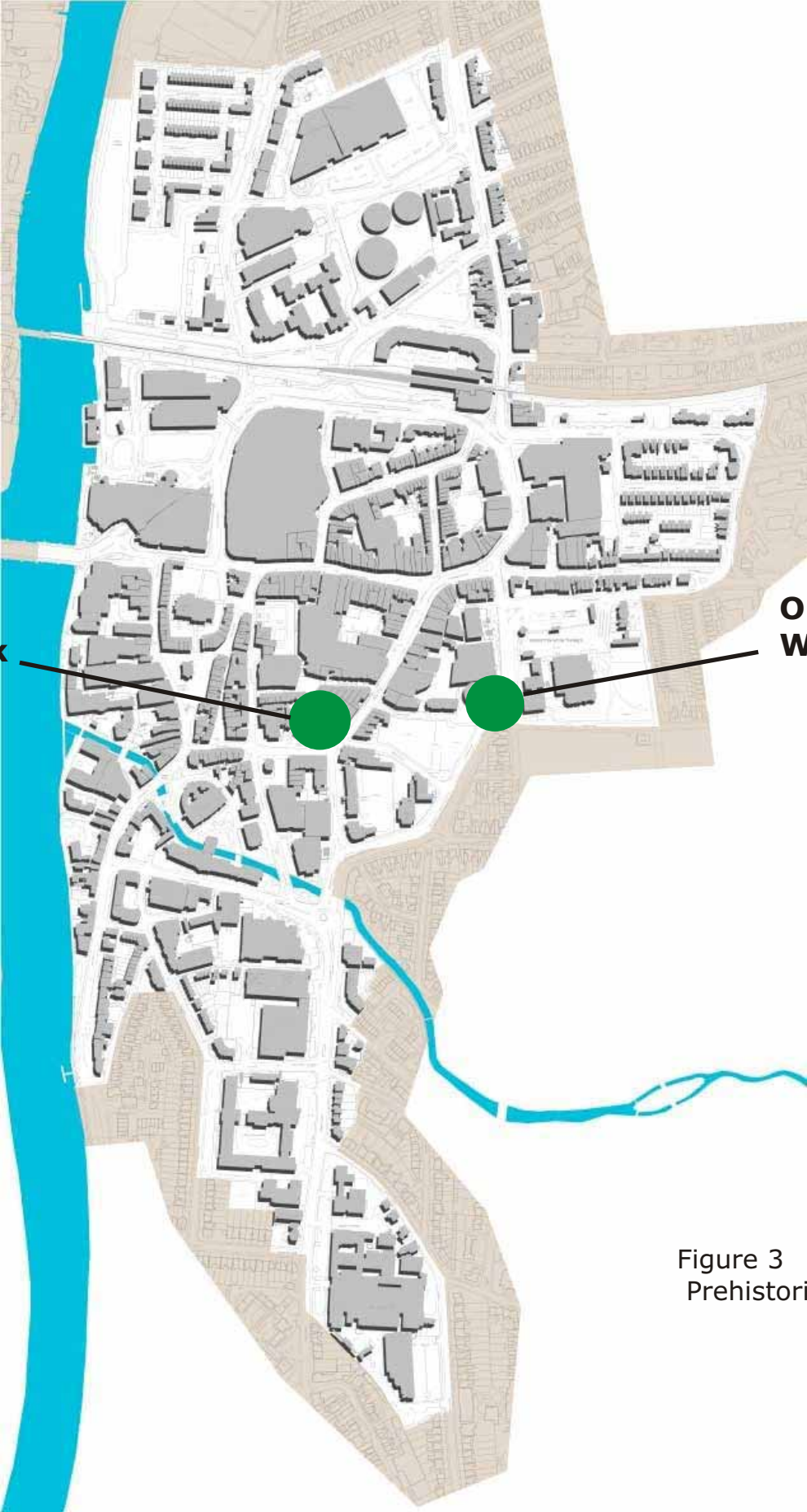

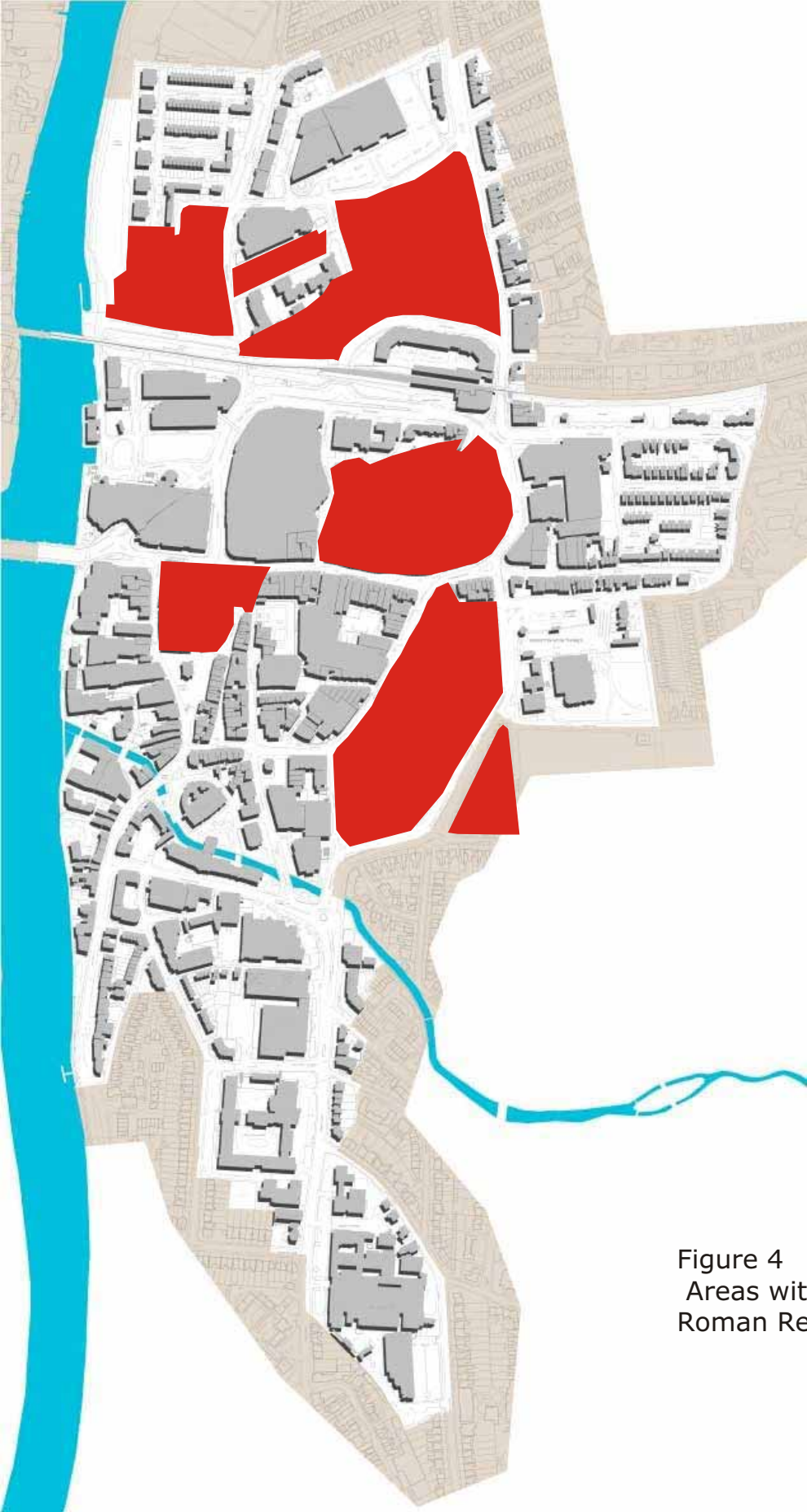

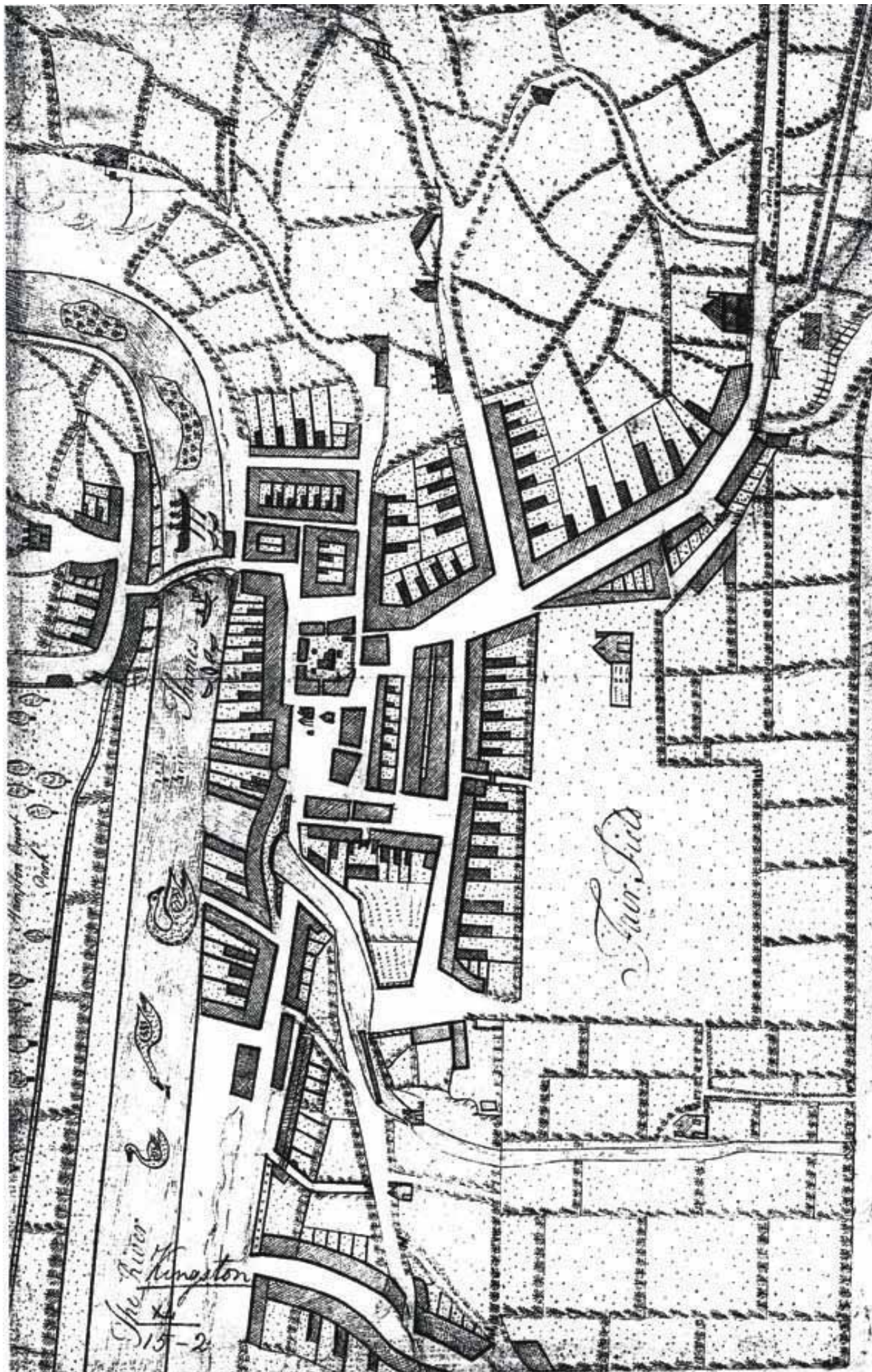

17th century map

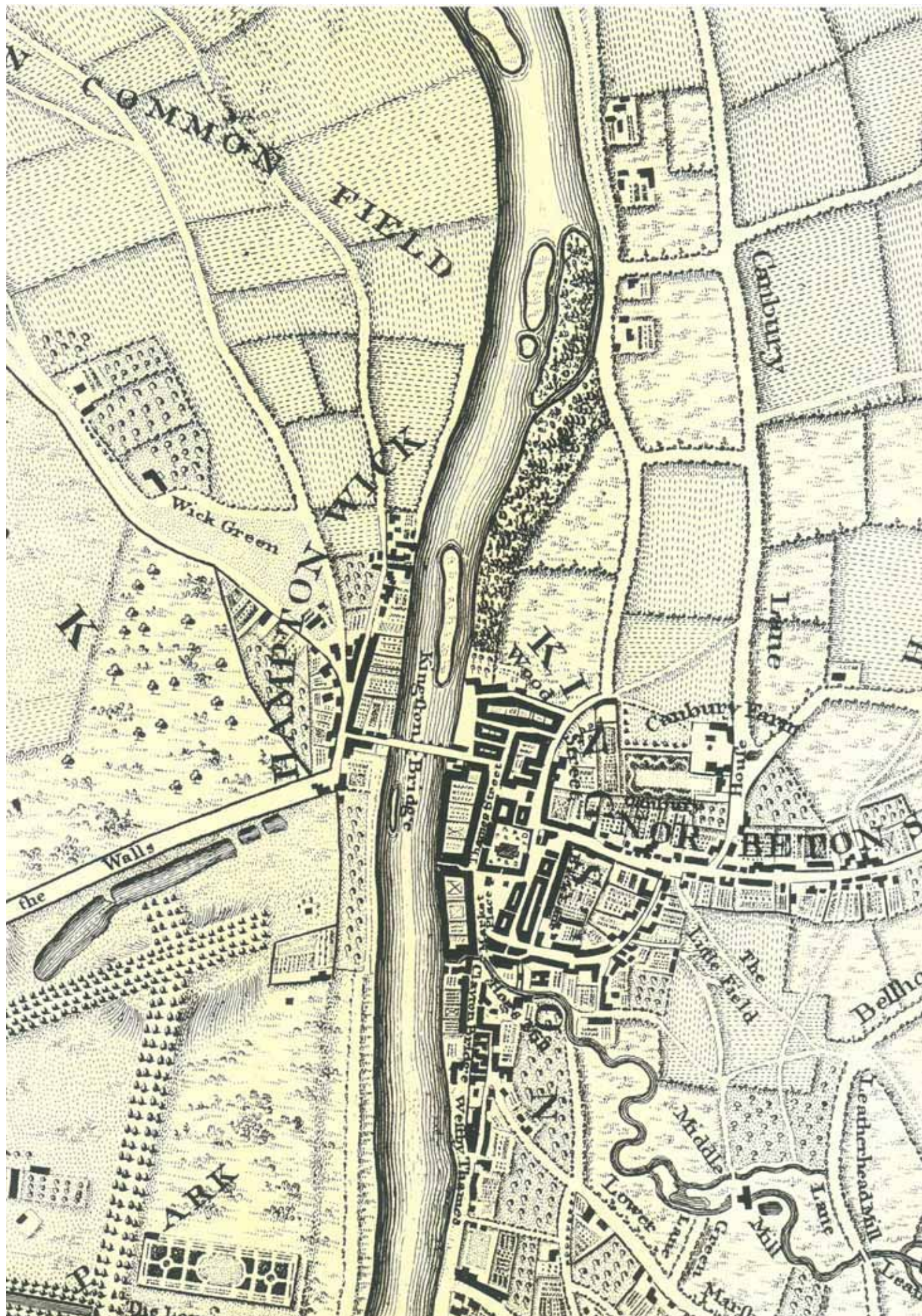

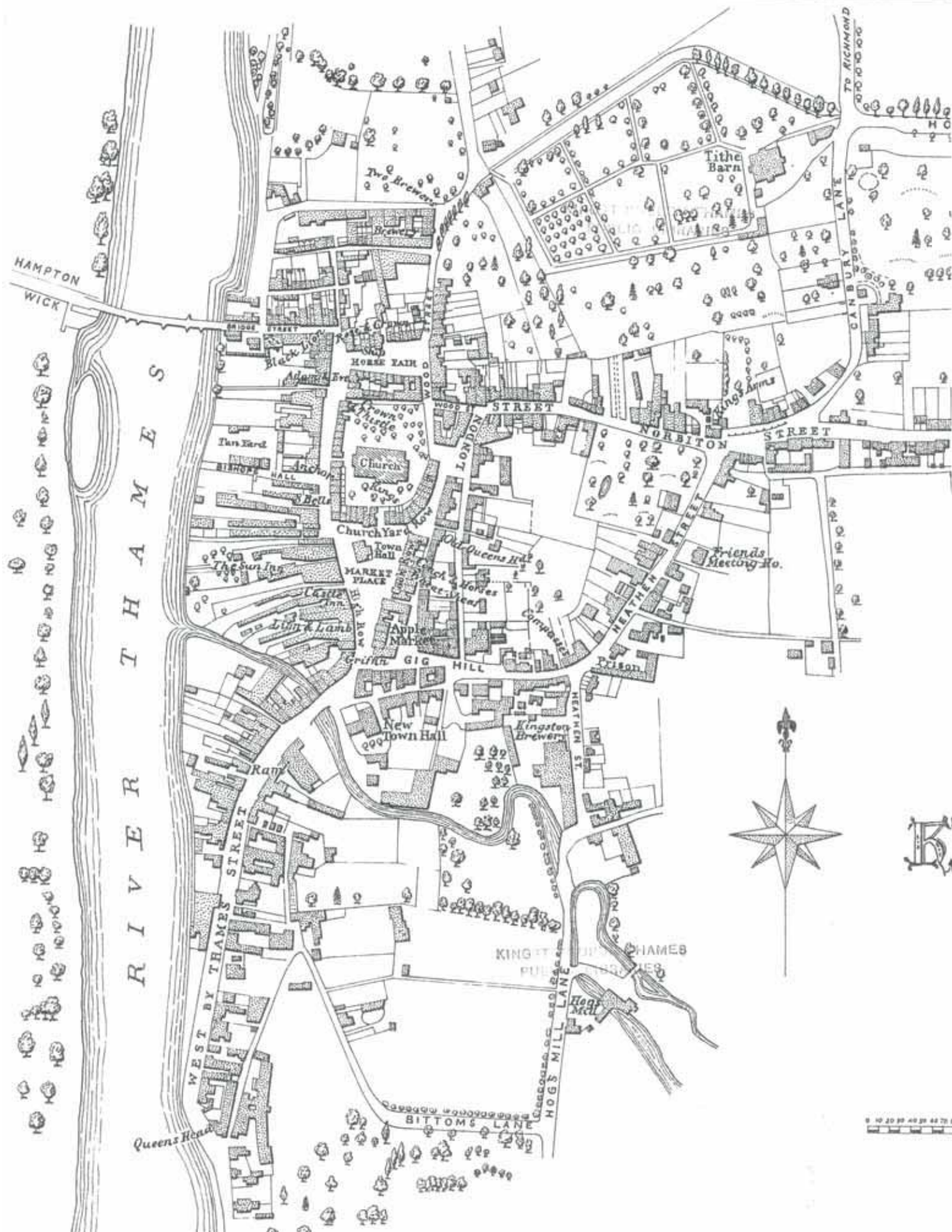

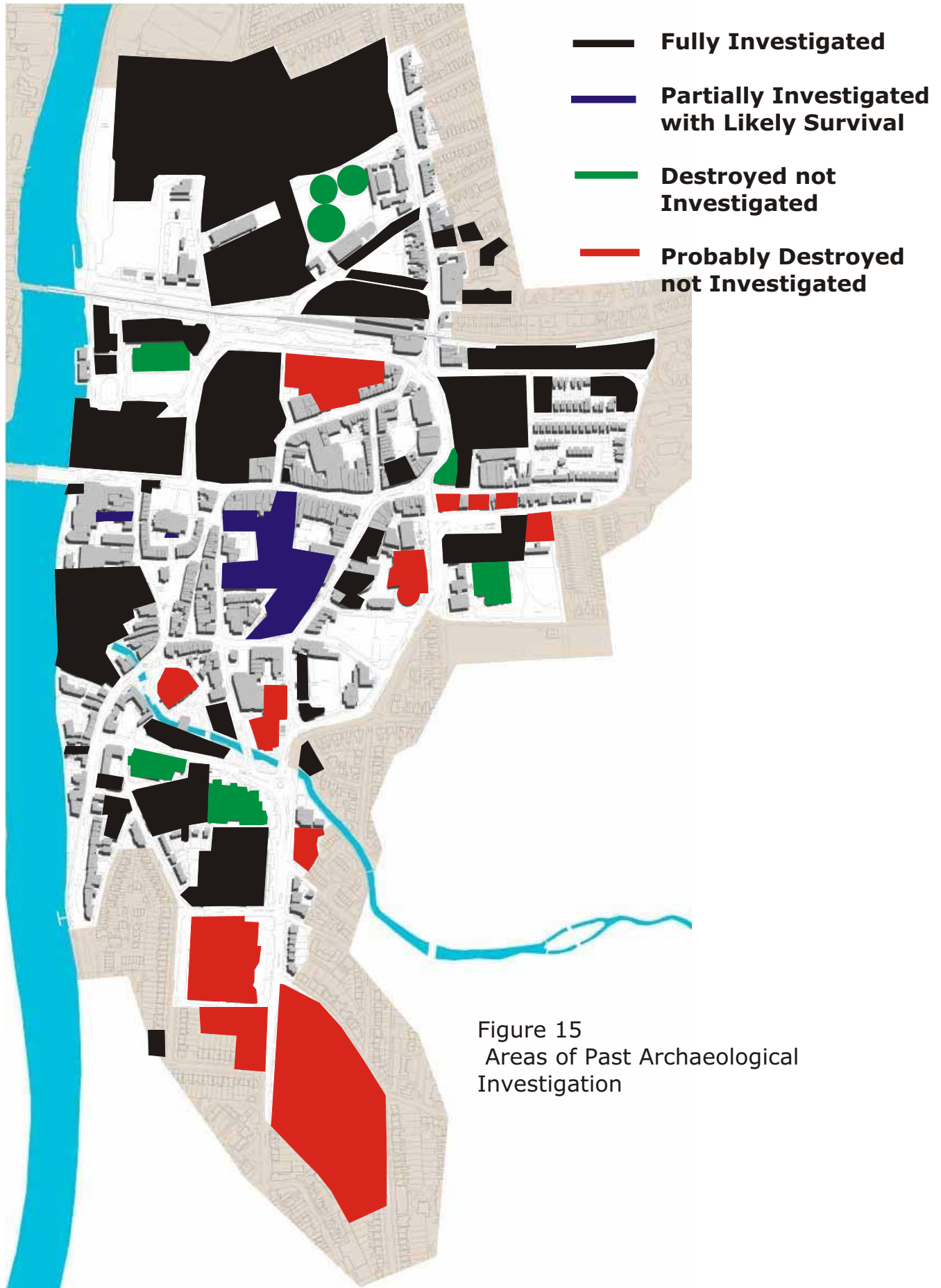

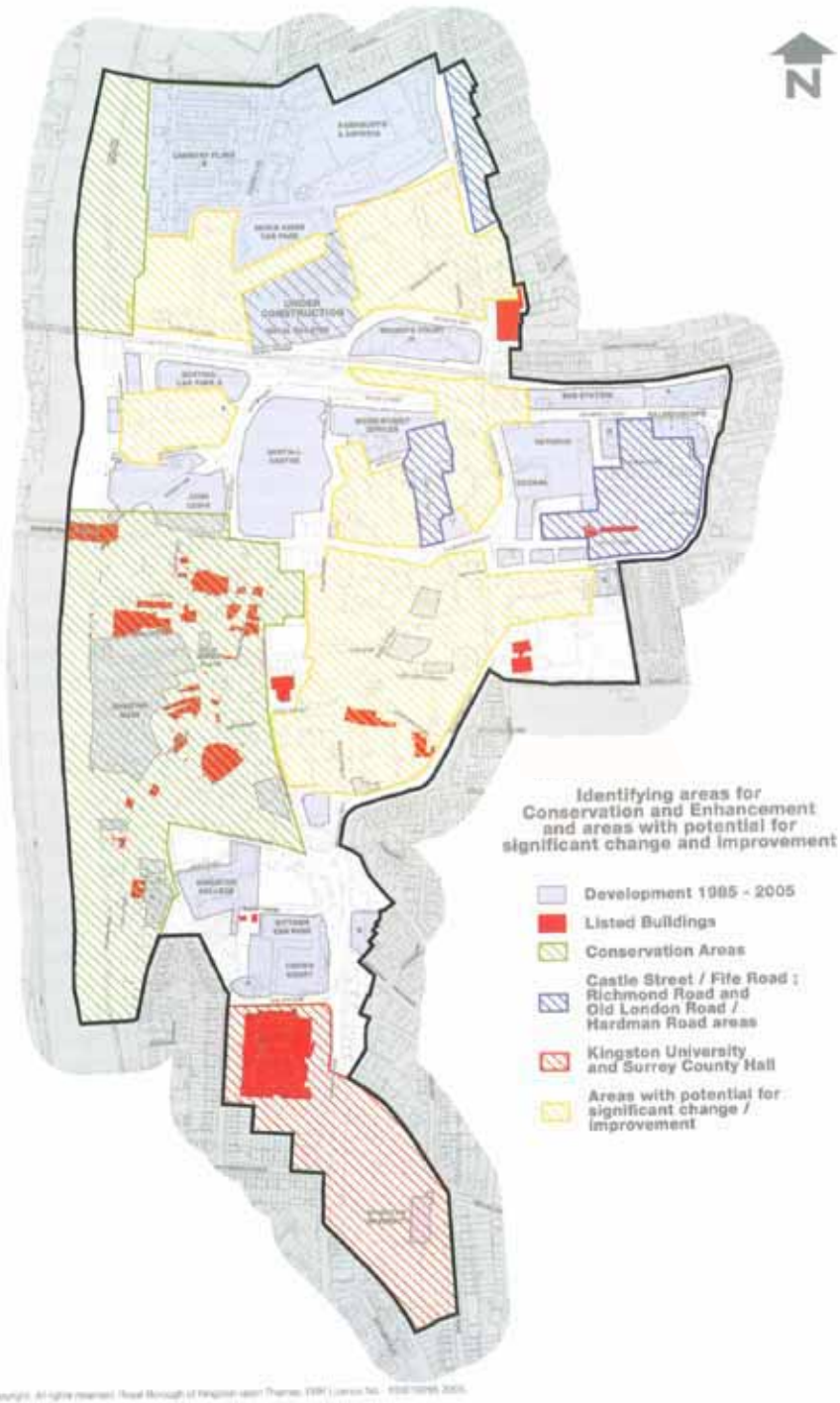

Preferred Options Vision

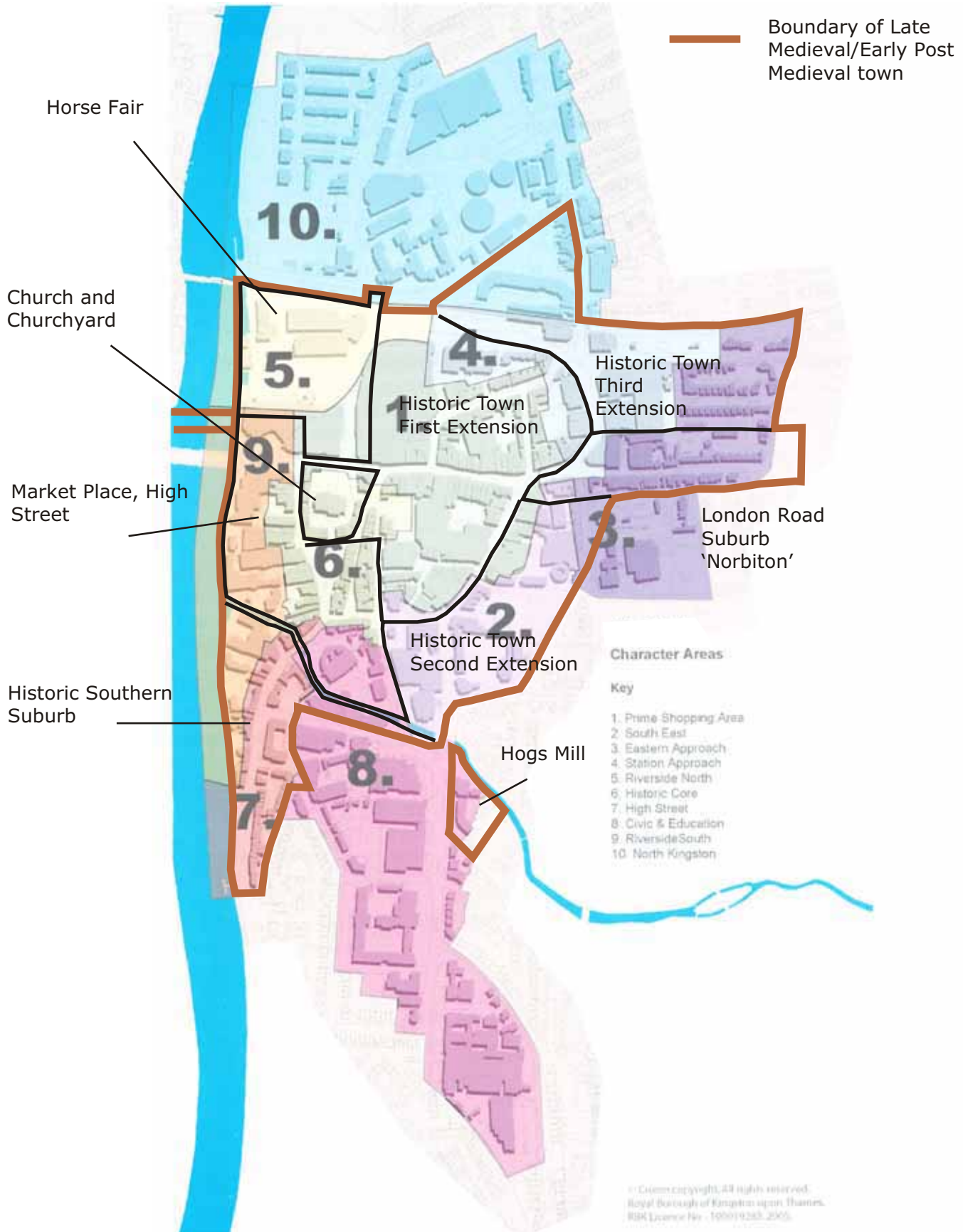
