Introduction

The Assessment & Support for Learning Service is responsible for fulfilling the statutory duties of the SEN & Disability Act 2001. SfL undertakes the LA's monitoring role at Annual Review and supports schools SEN practice.

Each school has an attached SfL teacher.

Core Service (Centrally Funded)

The Service normally works with SENCOs (at SA+ or Statement) to:

- Attend the Annual (or more frequent) Review of a Statement
- Advise on SEN interventions
- Assist schools to monitor and review pupil progress
- Lead on new strategies/programmes e.g. Jump Ahead, Early Bird.
- Advise on referrals to the LA's panel (known as SAAG).
- Support the induction of new SENCOs
- Develop staff awareness and skills
- Contribute to central CPD and Governor training
- Monitor the effectiveness of delegated Matrix funding

Service Available To Purchase

Governing Body training is available at a cost of £206 per hour (limited availability).
