

## Public Notice

### Enlargement of school premises at Burlington Infant and Nursery and Junior Schools

Notice is given in accordance with section 19(1) of the Education and Inspections Act 2006 that the Royal Borough of Kingston upon Thames intends to make a prescribed alteration to Burlington Infant and Nursery School, Burlington Road, New Malden, KT3 4LT and Burlington Junior School, Burlington Road, New Malden, KT3 4LT from 1 September 2011.

The Local Authority intends to increase the capacity of Burlington Infant and Nursery School by 90 places in order to provide the physical capacity for an additional form of entry to be accommodated from the start of the 2011/12 academic year. The current capacity of the school is 270 and the proposed capacity will be 360.

The Local Authority intends to increase the capacity of Burlington Junior School by 120 places in order to provide the physical capacity for an additional form of entry to be accommodated from the start of the 2011/12 academic year. The current capacity of the school is 360 and the proposed capacity will be 480.

The current number of pupils registered at the infant and nursery school is 326 and junior school is 360. The current admission number for both schools is 90 and the proposed admission number will be 120.

#### Explanatory Notes:

1. Following a substantial rise in the birth rate and subsequent increase in the number of resident children, the Local Authority has embarked upon a strategy to permanently increase the number of primary school places in the Borough.
2. The current roll of 326 at Burlington Infant and Nursery School includes two additional classes admitted over Published Admission Number in September 2008 and 2009 to provide a temporary increase in the number of places in Year R at the school. This first additional cohort will transfer into Burlington Junior School in September 2011.

3. Following the determination of this proposal, an application will be made in accordance with section 1.21 of the School Admissions Code to the Office of the Schools Adjudicator for an increase in both schools' Published Admission Numbers for September 2011.
