STATEMENT OF REASONS

This proposal extends the area of the existing 20 m.p.h. speed limit in Tolworth Broadway (which currently runs between its junction with Ewell Road and Oakleigh Way) to encompass the whole of Tolworth Broadway. This is part of the Tolworth 'Greenway' project which "aims to revitalize the Broadway to become a thriving place for people to enjoy and use, safely and securely" "by creating a more inviting and friendly environment and reducing traffic speeds".

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the Royal Borough of Kingston upon Thames propose to make the above-mentioned Order under section 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by the Local Government Act 1985.
2. The general effect of the Order would be to extend the area of the existing 20 m.p.h. speed limit in Tolworth Broadway (which currently runs between its junction with Ewell Road and Oakleigh Way) to encompass the whole of Tolworth Broadway.
3. The proposed Order and other documents giving more detailed particulars of the Order are available for inspection until 6 weeks have elapsed from the date on which either the Order is made or the Council decides not to make the Order at:

The Council of the Royal Borough of Kingston upon Thames, after consulting the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) as amended, and of all other powers thereunto enabling, hereby make the following Order: -

1. This Order shall come into force on \* 20\*\* and may be cited as the Kingston upon Thames (20 mph Speed Limit) (No. \*) Traffic Order 20\*\*.
2. Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into force of this Order, the Kingston upon Thames (20 mph Speed Limit) (No. 2) Traffic Order 2005(b) is hereby revoked.
3. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 20 miles per hour on any length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order.
4. No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011(c) when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.

## SCHEDULE

1. **Ewell Road** - between its junction with Elgar Avenue/Princes Avenue and the common boundary of Nos. 413 and 415 Ewell Road.
2. **Maple Road** - between its junction with The Mall/St. Andrew's Road and its junction with Grove Road.
3. **Tolworth Broadway** - both sides, throughout its entire length.
4. **Tolworth Close** - the south-easternmost arm.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

**(This Note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport.)**

This Order revokes and re-enacts the speed limit Order of 2005. In effect, the area of the speed limit is extended to encompass the whole of Tolworth Broadway.

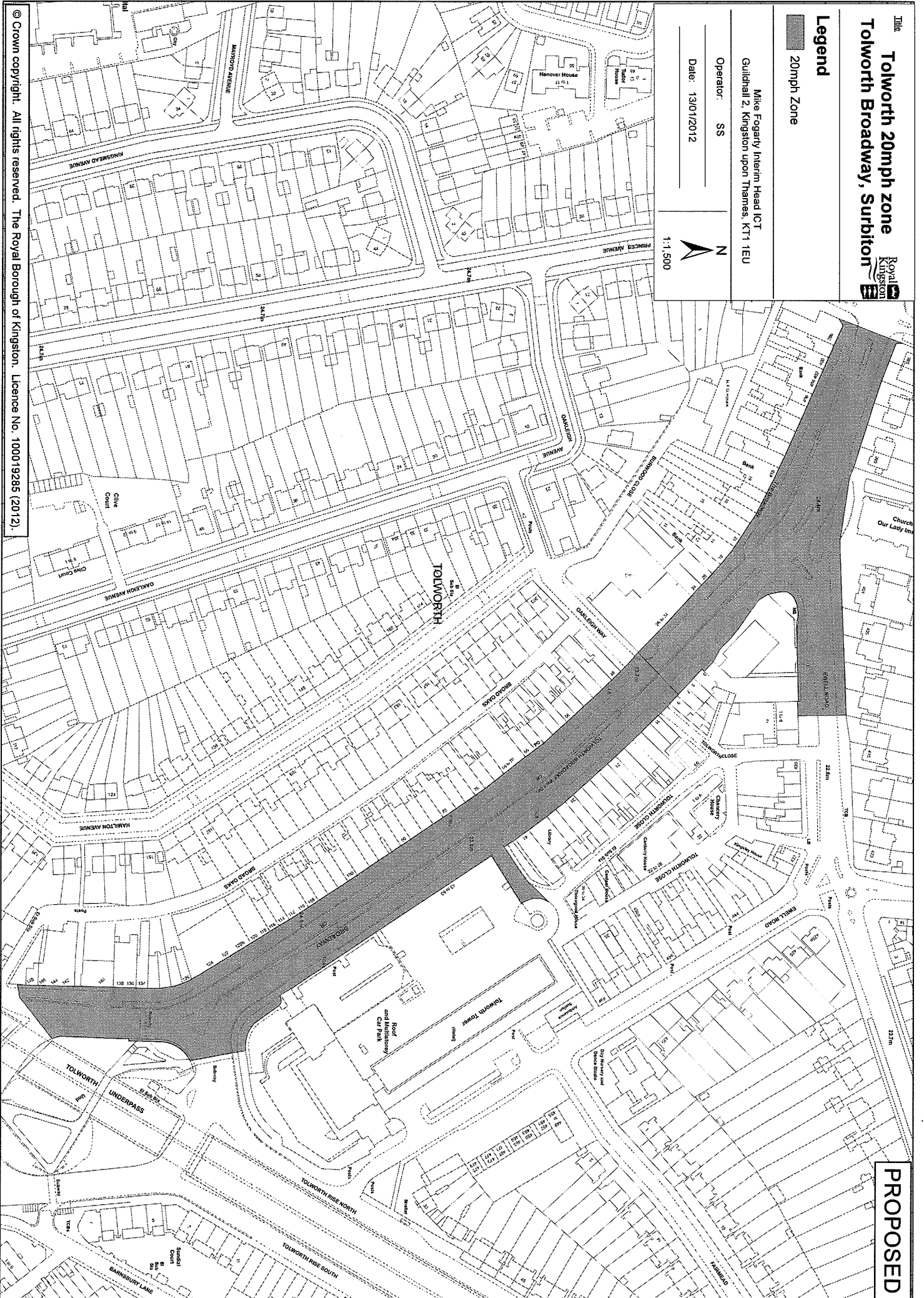
 20mph Zone

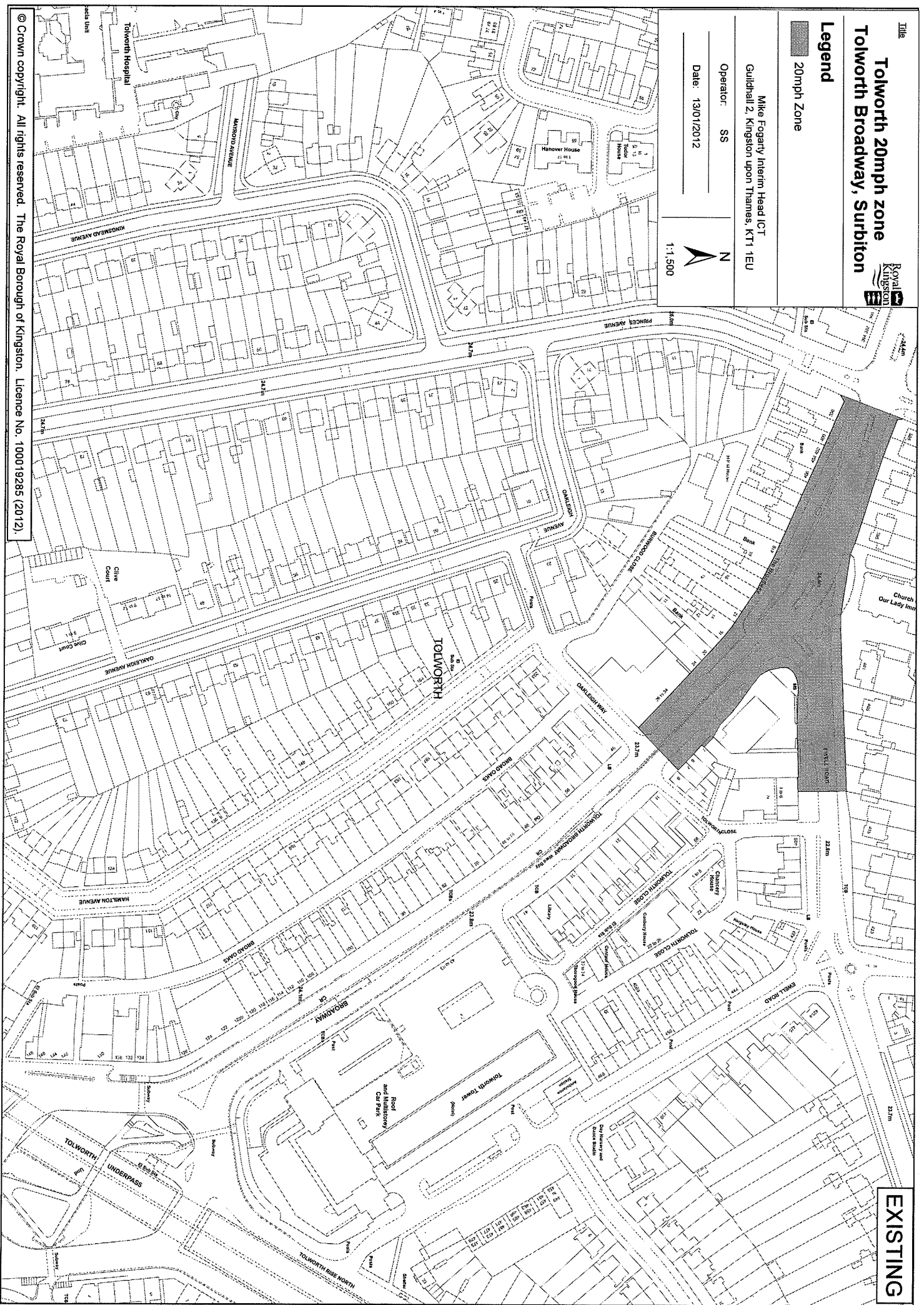
