

## Public Notice

### Enlargement of school premises at Ellingham Primary School

Notice is given in accordance with section 19(1) of the Education and Inspections Act 2006 that the Royal Borough of Kingston upon Thames intends to make a prescribed alteration to Ellingham Community Primary School, Ellingham Road, Chessington, Surrey, KT9 2JA from 1 September 2011.

The Local Authority intends to increase the capacity of Ellingham Primary School by 210 places in order to provide the physical capacity for an additional form of entry to be accommodated from the start of the 2011/12 academic year.

The current capacity of the school is 210 and the proposed capacity will be 420.

The current number of pupils registered at the school is 210. The current admission number for the school is 30 and the proposed admission number will be 60.
