

REFERRAL PROCEDURE:

1. Referral forms available from Fassett Road (Lisa Morris) or Allocations administrator .

2. Referral form to be completed by HAT (homeless assessment team) or referring agency and sent to the allocations administrator.

3. If eligibility criteria are fulfilled and there is a housing duty, the case will be considered at the multi agency panel.

4. If considered provisionally suitable at panel, the young woman will be invited to an interview with the Fassett Road interview panel, which includes representatives from social services and health.

5. The panel will consider the interview panels feedback and make a final decision on suitability regarding Placement.

6. If referral is rejected, the referring agency will be given notification. If successful the young woman will be housed at Fassett Road or placed on a waiting list according to priority need.

WHAT IS FASSETT ROAD ?

Fassett Road is a partnership between Richmond Upon Thames Churches Housing Trust (registered social landlord) and The Royal Borough of Kingston Upon Thames (Local Authority).

This partnership provides supported accommodation for young mothers between the ages of 16 and 22, who are homeless or in housing need.

The project offers low to medium support and as such the young woman must be able to live with their child with a degree of independence.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA :

-  Young Mothers between 16 - 22 years
-  20 plus weeks pregnant or have a child under 5 years old
-  Homeless, threatened with homelessness or in housing need
-  Possess basic independence skills (budgeting, cleaning, cooking, parenting)
-  Current severe mental health issues
-  Current substance misuse issues
-  Experiencing domestic violence
-  Requiring specialist assessment of parenting skills
-  Unable to meet accommodation and service charges

ACCOMMODATION:

Fassett Road is situated close to Kingston town centre and consists of 5 one bed roomed self contained flats. The building also houses an office which is staffed Mon - Fri, 9am -5pm.

Each flat consists of:

- Lounge
- Bathroom / toilet
- Kitchen
- Bedroom
- Appropriate flooring
- Cooker, washing machine and fridge freezer

SUPPORT :

Fassett Road aims to offer a support service concentrating on housing and tenancy issues. This support will be offered in a safe and supportive environment.

Daily contact (Mon - Fri)

Weekly life skills sessions

Fortnightly key work sessions

House meetings and activities

Peer support
