The Rules

The competition is open to all. The subject of the photograph is

“Capture Kingston Celebrating”

- Your entry may be taken with any type of camera, camera phone or professional quality camera.
- Your entry may be an original colour or black and white photographic image, enhanced or digitally manipulated.
- Your entry must be printed A3 size. Selected works will be displayed in standard A3 frames.
- All works must be safely packaged and must have your name and contact details securely attached on the reverse using the form provided on the back page of this leaflet.
- Entries must be delivered to John Lewis Gift List Department, first floor riverside next to Toys.
- Closing date for receipt of entries: **Friday 19th August 2011**

The finalists will have their work displayed in “The Place To Eat Restaurant” John Lewis Kingston. Selected works will be displayed from Monday September 5th.

There will be a prize giving evening on Thursday 8th September 6pm to announce the three winning photographs.

The photographs will be judged by a panel including **Sheridan Morley and Philip Hollis – editorial and reportage photographers from Click Photography Workshops, Jenny Tomley MD of John Lewis Kingston.**

John Lewis reserve the right to keep and use the winning images in future publicity material.

Entries not selected for exhibition can be collected from the Gift List Department from September 5th.

Finalists will be required to collect their photographs in person from the Gift list department from October 10th. Any prints not collected by October 31st will be disposed of.
