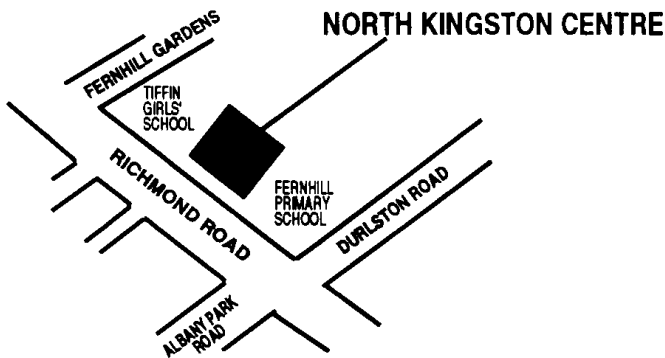

IF YOU WANT TO BECOME A BRITISH CITIZEN OR APPLY FOR SETTLEMENT YOU HAVE TO TAKE A CITIZENSHIP COURSE OR DO A TEST ON LINE

The ESOL department at the North Kingston Centre offers a 10 week course for those who need to improve their English and learn about citizenship. It is suitable for anyone whose English is at Entry Level 2 or 3. If your English skills are above this level you will have to do the test on line.

The course we offer is for 4 hours a week and runs for a total of 10 weeks. At the end of this time you will sit a nationally recognised Speaking and Listening exam and will receive written confirmation that you have completed the course successfully. You can then present this to the Home Office.

WHAT DOES ENTRY LEVEL 2/3 MEAN?

This means that you are able to take part in conversations and discussions on a familiar topic, and follow straightforward instructions and explanations. You should also be able to communicate your feelings and opinions with appropriate formality.

HOW DO I KNOW WHICH LEVEL I AM?

We will undertake a detailed assessment of your written and spoken English.



HOW MUCH WILL THE COURSE COST?

Course fees are subject to change. Please telephone or visit the office for up to date fee information

At the time of print our fees for the Citizenship course are:

- ◆ £101 for learners on income based benefits who have been resident in the EU for the past three years
- ◆ £175 for learners who are not on benefits but have been resident in the EU for the past three years
- ◆ £305 for learners who have not been resident in the EU for the past three years.

You will need to register and pay before you can join the course.

HOW DO I ENROL ON THE COURSE?

You will need to come to the ESOL Office, North Kingston Centre, for us to assess your eligibility. Please phone us and we will let you know which papers you need to bring. We will then give you a date for your level of English to be assessed.
