EXPRESSION OF WISH IN RESPECT OF DEATH GRANT

The Council has complete discretion regarding payment of any Death Grant due from the above Pension Scheme.

However you may wish to make an 'Expression of Wish' by completing the form below indicating to whom you would like the Death Grant paid. By making an Expression of Wish you will:

- ❖ **Help the Council decide to whom the Death Grant should be paid.**
- ❖ **Simplify and speed up the payment process.**
- ❖ **In most cases avoid liability to pay Inheritance Tax on the Death Grant.**

Although the Council will consider any Expression of Wish that you make, it is not bound by it. You can revise your Expression of Wish at any time by completing a further form. The Council will consider only your most recent Expression of Wish.

If the Council has not been able to pay the Death Grant to your beneficiary/beneficiaries within two years of your death, it will be paid to your Estate. This might happen if the Council is unable to contact them.
