### INTRODUCTION OF "PAY BY PHONE" FACILITY IN CAR PARKS

#### THE KINGSTON UPON THAMES (PARKING PLACES) (AMENDMENT NO. \*) ORDER 20\*\*

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the Royal Borough of Kingston upon Thames propose to make the above Order under sections 32, 35, 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.

2. The general effects of the Order would be to amend certain provisions of the Borough's off-street (car parks) Order as follows;

- (a) payment of the parking charge can be made, where available, using "pay by phone" technology (via connection with the Council's service provider). The "pay by phone" system will not be available immediately but advance notice will be advertised locally before installation;
- (b) if only one method of payment of the parking charge is available (i.e. cash or "pay by phone"), that method must be used;
- (c) at the Malden Centre car park, introduce parking charges on Sundays 11 a.m. to 5 p.m.

3. The proposed Order and other documents giving more detailed particulars of the Order are available for inspection until 6 weeks have elapsed from the date on which either the Order is made or the Council decides not to make the Order at:

- The Information and Advice Centre, Guildhall 2, Kingston upon Thames, KT1 1EU between 8.30 a.m. and 5.00 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays inclusive;
- Hook & Chessington Library, The Hook Centre, Hook Road, Chessington during normal opening hours;
- Kingston Library, Fairfield Road, Kingston, during normal opening hours;
- New Malden Library, Sandal Road, New Malden, during normal opening hours;
- Surbiton Library, Ewell Road, Surbiton, during normal opening hours.

5. Any objections or other representations about the proposals should be sent in writing to the Director (Place and Regeneration), Traffic Order Section, Guildhall 2, Kingston upon Thames, Surrey, KT1 1EU by 20<sup>th</sup> May 2011. All objections must specify the grounds on which they are made.
