

# Primary School Expansion in the Royal Borough of Kingston upon Thames from September 2011

## Please tell us your views

Kingston Council is legally responsible for making sure there are enough school places in the borough for all the children that need one. To meet the rising demand for places, Kingston Council is planning to increase the number of primary school places in the borough.

This document gives information on the plans to increase primary school places permanently from September 2011. Temporary classes are being planned for September 2010 while the building work is being undertaken.

**We would like to know your views on the choices available for permanent expansion of the schools. Please fill in the attached form and return it to us by 15 June 2009.**

The demand for school places varies across the borough. To help us plan, the borough is split into four areas. Kingston Council has been working closely with all the schools to give as much choice as we can. It is not possible to expand every school.

The final plan for the expansion of primary school places will combine the results from this consultation, availability of land for new schools, likely outcome of planning applications and the practical issues of expanding the schools.
