

ROYAL BOROUGH OF KINGSTON UPON THAMES

MINOR PARKING AMENDMENTS CANBURY, RIVERSIDE & SURBITON CONTROLLED PARKING ZONES

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the Royal Borough of Kingston upon Thames propose to make the following Orders under sections 45, 46, 49 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended:

- The Kingston upon Thames (Parking Places) (Canbury) (Amendment No. *) Traffic Order 20**;
- The Kingston upon Thames (Parking Places) (Riverside) (Amendment No. *) Traffic Order 20**;
- The Kingston upon Thames (Parking Places) (Surbiton) (No. 3) (Amendment No. *) Traffic Order 20**.

2. The general effect of the Orders would, for the purpose of allowing access to off-street parking areas, be;

- in Canbury Avenue, Kingston, to remove the Permit Holder parking place outside No. 90;
- in Church Hill Road, Surbiton, to remove part of the Permit Holder parking place (opposite 'Court Royal') and extend the same parking place (opposite 'Red Roofs') south-eastwards by approximately 8 metres; and
- in Westfield Road, Surbiton, to remove the Permit Holder parking place outside No. 11.

3. The proposed Orders, and other documents giving more detailed particulars of the Orders, including plans showing their location and effect, are available for inspection until 6 weeks have elapsed from the date on which either the Orders are made or the Council decides not to make the Orders at:

- The Information and Advice Centre, Guildhall 2, Kingston upon Thames, KT1 1EU between 8.30 a.m. and 5.00 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays inclusive;
- Kingston Library, Fairfield Road, Kingston during normal opening hours;
- Surbiton Library, Ewell Road, Surbiton during normal opening hours; and
- Tudor Library, Tudor Drive, Kingston during normal opening hours.

5. Any objections or other representations about the proposed Orders should be sent in writing to the Director (Place and Regeneration), Traffic Order Section, Guildhall 2, Kingston upon Thames, Surrey, KT1 1EU by 1st April 2011. All objections must specify the grounds on which they are made.
