TAXI RANK & DISABLED PERSONS' PARKING PLACES ST. JAMES'S ROAD, KINGSTON

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the Royal Borough of Kingston upon Thames propose to make the following Orders under sections 6, 45, 46, 49 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended: -

- The Kingston upon Thames (Free Parking Places) (Disabled Persons) (Special Parking Area) (Amendment No. *) Traffic Order 20**;
- Kingston upon Thames (Prohibition of Stopping on Taxi Ranks) (Amendment No. *) Traffic Order 20**;
- The Kingston Upon Thames (Parking Places) (New Malden) (No. 2) (Amendment No. *) Traffic Order 20**

2. The general effect of the Orders would be to;

(a) remove a taxi rank from St. James's Road (adjacent to its junction with Eden Street);

(b) relocate a disabled persons' parking place from Bath Passage (adjacent to St. James's Road) to St. James's Road (adjacent to its junction with Eden Street i.e. the same location as the abovementioned taxi rank).

The parking place in Bath Passage currently accommodates 1 vehicle whereas this relocated bay would accommodate 2 vehicles.

(Vehicles displaying a valid disabled persons' badge may wait in the above parking place without charge between 8 a.m. and 10.30 p.m. for a maximum stay of 3 hours).

(c) convert a 'pay & display' parking place in Burlington Road, New Malden from 'parking meter' to 'ticket parking meter' operation;

3. The proposed Orders, and other documents giving more detailed particulars of the proposals, including plans showing the location and effect, are available for inspection until 6 weeks have elapsed from the date on which either the Orders are made or the Council decides not to make the Orders at:

- The Information and Advice Centre, Guildhall 2, Kingston upon Thames, KT1 1EU between 8.30 a.m. and 5.00 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays inclusive;
- Kingston Library, Fairfield Road, Kingston, during normal opening hours;
- New Malden Library, Kingston Road, New Malden during normal opening hours.
