

ROYAL BOROUGH OF KINGSTON UPON THAMES

PROPOSED 20 MPH SPEED LIMITS- NEW MALDEN & SURBITON & SPEED TABLE (LANGLEY ROAD, SURBITON)

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the Royal Borough of Kingston upon Thames propose to make The Kingston Upon Thames (20 MPH Speed Limit) (No.*) Traffic Order 20** under section 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by the Local Government Act 1985.

2. The general effect of the Order would be to impose a speed limit of 20 miles per hour in the following areas and roads:

- **New Malden**

Dickerage Lane and Dickerage Road (south of Clarence Avenue)
Theftford Road (outside 'The Study School')

- **Surbiton**

Brook Road, Gladstone Road, Haycroft Road and Verona Drive
Grand Avenue (between Greenfield Avenue and Nos. 70-72) and Greenfield Avenue (between Nos. 51-53 and Nos. 66-68)
Langley Road (outside St. Matthew's Primary School). Also see proposed speed table below.
Ravenscar Road, Tankerton Road and Tolworth Park Road (N.B. these Orders formalise the existing 20 mph speed limit in these roads)

3. The Council also proposes to introduce a speed table in Langley Road, Surbiton (at the existing narrowing of the road outside Brockley Court) in accordance with section 90A of the Highways Act 1980 (as amended). The speed table would be an elevated section of carriageway with a maximum height of 75mm, 4.5 metres in length and would occupy the full width of the carriageway.

4. The Order, and other documents giving more detailed particulars of the proposals, including plans showing the roads affected by the proposed speed limit, are available for inspection until 6 weeks have elapsed from the date on which either the Order is made or the Council decides not to make the Order at: -

- The Information and Advice Centre, Guildhall 2, Kingston upon Thames, KT1 1EU between 8.30 a.m. and 5.00 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays inclusive;
- Hook & Chessington Library, The Hook Centre, Hook Road, Chessington during normal opening hours;
- New Malden Library, Sandal Road, New Malden during normal opening hours;
- Surbiton Library, Ewell Road, Surbiton during normal opening hours.

6. Any objections or other representations about the proposed Order should be sent in writing to the Director (Place and Regeneration), Traffic Order Section, Guildhall 2, Kingston upon Thames, Surrey, KT1 1EU by 11th March 2011. All objections must specify the grounds on which they are made.
