1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the Royal Borough of Kingston upon Thames propose to make the above Orders under sections 6, 45, 46, 49 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.
2. The general effects of the Orders would be;
  - in Avenue Elmers, Surbiton (at the side of No. 134 Maple Road), to convert the existing “shared use” parking place to a “buses only” parking place (maximum stay 20 minutes);
  - in Avenue Elmers, Surbiton, to shorten (by approximately 6 metres at each end) the “school keep clear” area outside Surbiton High Boys’ Preparatory School, lengthening the adjacent “permit holder” & “shared use” parking places accordingly;
  - in Ardmay Gardens, Surbiton (at its junction with Avenue Elmers), to lengthen (by 5 metres) the existing “permit holder” parking place.
3. The proposed Orders and other documents giving more detailed particulars of the Orders are available for inspection until 6 weeks have elapsed from the date on which either the Orders are made or the Council decides not to make the Orders at:
  - The Information and Advice Centre, Guildhall 2, Kingston upon Thames, KT1 1EU between 8.30 a.m. and 5.00 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays inclusive;
  - Surbiton Library, Ewell Road, Surbiton, during normal opening hours.

Any objections or other representations about the proposed Orders should be sent in writing to the Director (Place and Regeneration), Traffic Order Section, Guildhall 2, Kingston upon Thames, Surrey, KT1 1EU by 15<sup>th</sup> July 2011. All objections must specify the grounds on which they are made.
