

ROYAL BOROUGH OF KINGSTON UPON THAMES

CONTROLLED PARKING ZONE AMENDMENTS PARKING PERMIT CONDITIONS

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the Royal Borough of Kingston upon Thames propose to make the following Order under sections 45, 46, 49 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended:

- The Kingston upon Thames (Parking Places) (Amendment No. *) Order 20**.

2. The general effects of the Order would be to amend certain provisions of the Borough's 'Controlled Parking Zone' Orders as follows;

- (a) to increase the maximum number of Business Parking Permits available to each business user from 2 to 3 permits;
- (b) to assign charges for the proposed 3rd Business Parking Permit as follows; £600 (1 year), £360 (6 months) and £200 (3 months).
- (c) to amend the conditions for refund of unexpired Parking Permits so that a refund for a Business or Residents' Parking Permit be given for blocks of 3 complete months before expiry date (currently, a refund is given for each complete month).

Please note:-

- these proposals are an amended version of the notice advertised on 24th December 2010. Following objections to the previous proposals, the quantity of parking permits available to each business user is to be limited, as above; and
- Business Parking Permits will continue to be unavailable in Kingston Town (Zone A/A1).

3. The proposed Order and other documents giving more detailed particulars of the Order are available for inspection until 6 weeks have elapsed from the date on which either the Order is made or the Council decides not to make the Order at:

- The Information and Advice Centre, Guildhall 2, Kingston upon Thames, KT1 1EU between 8.30 a.m. and 5.00 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays inclusive;
- Hook & Chessington Library, The Hook Centre, Hook Road, Chessington during normal opening hours;
- Kingston Library, Fairfield Road, Kingston, during normal opening hours;
- New Malden Library, Sandal Road, New Malden, during normal opening hours;
- Old Malden Library, Church Road, Worcester Park, during normal opening hours;
- Surbiton Library, Ewell Road, Surbiton, during normal opening hours;
- Tolworth Community Library, 37–39 The Broadway, Tolworth, during normal opening hours; and
- Tudor Drive Library, Tudor Drive, Kingston during normal opening hours.
