1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the Royal Borough of Kingston upon Thames propose to make the above Orders under sections 6 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.
2. The general effects of the Orders would be;
  - to remove the width restrictions in Sanger Avenue (at its junction with Cox Lane);
  - to remove the exemption for permit holders who may currently enter the bus areas in Cox Lane (between Sanger Avenue & Oakcroft Road);
  - to formalise the boundary of the existing 7.5 tonnes weight limit zone at the junction between Cox Lane & Sanger Avenue.
3. The proposed Orders and other documents giving more detailed particulars of the Orders are available for inspection until 6 weeks have elapsed from the date on which either the Orders are made or the Council decides not to make the Orders at:
  - The Information and Advice Centre, Guildhall 2, Kingston upon Thames, KT1 1EU between 8.30 a.m. and 5.00 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays inclusive;
  - Hook & Chessington Library, The Hook Centre, Hook Road, Chessington during normal opening hours.
