

ROYAL BOROUGH OF KINGSTON UPON THAMES

DISABLED PERSONS' PARKING PLACES

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the Royal Borough of Kingston upon Thames propose to make the following Orders under sections 6, 45, 46, 49 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended: -

- The Kingston upon Thames (Free Parking Places) (Disabled Persons) (Special Parking Area) (No. 2) Traffic Order 20**;
- The Kingston upon Thames (Parking Places) (Canbury) (Amendment No. *) Traffic Order 20**;
- The Kingston upon Thames (Parking Places) (Special Parking Area) (Grove Area) (Amendment No. *) Traffic Order 20**;
- The Kingston upon Thames (Parking Places) (Norbiton) (Amendment No. *) Traffic Order 20**;
- The Kingston upon Thames (Parking Places) (Riverside) (Amendment No. *) Traffic Order 20**;
- The Kingston upon Thames (Waiting and Loading Restriction) (Amendment No. *) Traffic Order 20**.

2. The general effect of the Orders would be to;

(a) revoke and re-enact the existing Disabled Persons' Parking Places Orders (by merging the Orders of 1994 and 1995);

(b) add disabled persons' parking places at the following locations:

Acre Road, Kingston	- outside Kingston Mosque (<i>to replace a 'shared use' parking space</i>)
Albury Road, Chessington	- outside No. 18
Kingston Road, Kingston	- outside No. 417 (<i>on the footway</i>)
Mount Road, New Malden	- outside No. 43 (<i>N.B. also shorten by 1 metre the double yellow line waiting restriction outside No. 47</i>)
Shortlands Road, Kingston	- outside No. 24 (<i>to replace a 'permit holder' parking space</i>)
Shortlands Road, Kingston	- outside No. 77 (<i>to replace a 'permit holder' parking space</i>)
St Andrew's Square, Surbiton	- outside No. 15 (<i>to replace a 'permit holder' parking space</i>)
Windsor Avenue, New Malden	- outside No. 85

(Vehicles displaying a valid disabled persons' badge may wait in the above parking places without charge or time limit);

(c) remove redundant disabled persons' parking places from the following locations:

Blagdon Road, New Malden	- outside No. 64
Browns Road, Surbiton	- outside No. 4
Chantry Road, Chessington	- outside No. 58
Cleveland Road, New Malden	- outside No. 48
Dickerage Road, New Malden	- side of No. 40 Coombe Lane West
Green Lane, Chessington	- outside No. 16
Hereford Way, Chessington	- outside No. 3
Kingshill Avenue, Worcester Park	- outside No. 196
Norbiton Avenue, Kingston	- outside No. 14 (<i>to be replaced by a 'permit holder' parking space</i>)
Oxford Crescent, New Malden	- side of No. 207 Malden Way
Portland Road, Kingston	- outside No. 25 (<i>to be replaced by a 'permit holder' parking space</i>)
Reynolds Avenue, Chessington	- outside Nos. 46/48
Sanger Avenue, Chessington	- outside No. 69

- Vincent Road, Kingston - outside No. 4 (*to be replaced by a 'permit holder' parking space*)
- Worthington Road, Surbiton - outside No. 53

(d) amend the times of restriction of the following existing disabled persons' parking places:

- Church Road, Worcester Park - amend to Mon-Sat 8a.m.-6.30p.m. (both bays, outside Old Malden Library)
- Ditton Road, Surbiton - amend to Mon-Fri 8a.m.-6.30p.m. (opposite No. 80)
- Hook Rise South, Surbiton - amend to Mon-Sat 8a.m.-6.30p.m. (outside No. 309)
- Manor Drive North, Worcester Park - amend to Mon-Sat 8a.m.-6.30p.m. (outside Nos. 111-113)
- North Parade, Chessington - amend to 'at any time' (both bays, outside Nos. 16-22)
- Tolworth Broadway, Surbiton - amend to Mon-Fri 9.30a.m.-4.30p.m., 7p.m.-midnight, Sat-Sun 8a.m.-midnight (outside No. 41 & No. 94)

(e) increase the maximum stay period from 2 hours to 3 hours at the disabled persons' parking place outside 'Lidl', Blagdon Road, New Malden;

(f) relocate a disabled persons' parking place by 1 metre to the north-east (outside No. 22, Thetford Road, New Malden);

(g) relocate a 'permit holders' parking place by 4 metres to the south-west (outside No. 92a, King's Road, Kingston);

(h) lengthen a 'permit holders' parking place by 2 metres southwards (outside No. 10, Albert Road, Kingston).

3. The proposed Orders, and other documents giving more detailed particulars of the proposals, including plans showing the location and effect, are available for inspection until 6 weeks have elapsed from the date on which either the Orders are made or the Council decides not to make the Orders at:

- The Information and Advice Centre, Guildhall 2, Kingston upon Thames, KT1 1EU between 8.30 a.m. and 5.00 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays inclusive;
- Hook & Chessington Library, The Hook Centre, Hook Road, Chessington during normal opening hours;
- Kingston Library, Fairfield Road, Kingston, during normal opening hours;
- New Malden Library, Sandal Road, New Malden, during normal opening hours;
- Old Malden Library, church Road, Worcester Park, during normal opening hours;
- Surbiton Library, Ewell Road, Surbiton, during normal opening hours;
- Tolworth Community Library, 37-39 The Broadway, Tolworth, during normal opening hours.
