

ROYAL BOROUGH OF KINGSTON UPON THAMES
MINOR PARKING AMENDMENTS - KINGSTON
EAST LANE, CANBURY CPZ & CANBURY GARDENS CPZ

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the Royal Borough of Kingston upon Thames propose to make the following Orders under sections 6, 45, 46, 49 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended:

- The Kingston upon Thames (Free Parking Places) (Disabled Persons) (Special Parking Area) (Amendment No. *) Traffic Order 20**;
- The Kingston upon Thames (Free Parking Places) (Goods Vehicles) (Amendment No. *) (Special Parking Area) Traffic Order 20**;
- The Kingston upon Thames (Parking Places) (Kingston) (Amendment No. *) Traffic Order 20**;
- The Kingston upon Thames (Waiting And Loading Restriction) (Amendment No. *) Traffic Order 20**;
- The Kingston upon Thames (Parking Places) (Canbury) (Amendment No. *) Traffic Order 20**;
- The Kingston upon Thames (Parking Places) (Canbury Gardens) (Amendment No. *) Traffic Order 20**.

2. The general effect of the Orders would be;

- in East Lane,
 - to replace the existing disabled persons' parking place (to be relocated, as below) with a parking place for the loading & unloading of goods vehicles only, between 7 a.m & 10.30 p.m., maximum stay 30 minutes;
 - to replace the existing 'pay & display' parking place with a disabled persons' parking place (opposite Nos. 1 to 4);
- in Canbury Controlled Parking Zone;
 - in St George's Road, to lengthen a 'permit holders only' parking place (outside No. 12);
- in Canbury Gardens Controlled Parking Zone;
 - in Eastbury Road, to lengthen a 'shared use' parking place (opposite No. 39);
 - in Woodside Road, to add a 'shared use' parking place (outside No. 1);
 - in Woodside Road, to lengthen a 'shared use' parking place (outside No. 15 & No. 6 Waterman's Close).

3. The proposed Orders, and other documents giving more detailed particulars of the Orders, including plans showing their location and effect, are available for inspection until 6 weeks have elapsed from the date on which either the Orders are made or the Council decides not to make the Orders at:

- The Information and Advice Centre, Guildhall 2, Kingston upon Thames, KT1 1EU between 8.30 a.m. and 5.00 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays inclusive;
- Kingston Library, Fairfield Road, Kingston during normal opening hours; and
- Tudor Drive Library, Tudor Drive, Kingston during normal opening hours.
