

## ROYAL BOROUGH OF KINGSTON UPON THAMES

### ELECTRIC VEHICLE RECHARGING POINTS

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the Royal Borough of Kingston upon Thames propose to make the following Orders under sections 6, 45, 46, 49 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended:

- The Kingston upon Thames (Electric Vehicle Recharging Points) (No. 1) Traffic Order 20\*\*;
- The Kingston upon Thames (Parking Places) (Surbiton) (No. 3) (Amendment No. \*) Traffic Order 20\*\*;
- The Kingston upon Thames (Parking Places) (Kingston) (No.1) (Amendment No. \*) Traffic Order 20\*\*;
- The Kingston upon Thames (Free Parking Places) (Disabled Persons) (Special Parking Area) (No. 2) (Amendment No. \*) Traffic Order 20\*\*.

2. The general effect of the Orders would be to designate on-street recharging points for electric vehicles at various locations (see table below) which would operate as follows;

(a) the recharging points would be available for electric vehicles only “at any time”, without charge, provided that the vehicle is connected to the recharging post (via a recharging lead provided by the Council) at all times while it is left at the recharging point;

(b) electric vehicles would be restricted to a maximum stay of three hours at the recharging points;

(c) if a vehicle is left at a recharging point, it may not return to that recharging point on the same day.

Please note:- membership of ‘Source London’ is required before using a charging point.

#### **Proposed locations of Electric Vehicle Charging Points**

Chessington	Bridge Road	- on the north side, opposite No. 136;
Kingston	Fairfield Road	- to replace a ‘Pay & Display’ parking space (on the north side, outside The Kingfisher Sports Centre);
Kingston	Union Street	- to replace a ‘Disabled’ parking space (on the west side, outside No. 9);
Surbiton	Claremont Road	- to replace a ‘Shared Use’ parking space (on the west side, opposite No. 34);
Surbiton	St. Mark’s Hill	- to replace a ‘Pay & Display’ parking space (on the south-east side, opposite No. 9).

3. The proposed Orders, and other documents giving more detailed particulars of the Orders, including plans showing their location and effect, are available for inspection until 6 weeks have elapsed from the date on which either the Orders are made or the Council decides not to make the Orders at:

- The Information and Advice Centre, Guildhall 2, Kingston upon Thames, KT1 1EU between 8.30 a.m. and 5.00 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays inclusive;
- Hook & Chessington Library, The Hook Centre, Hook Road, Chessington during normal opening hours;
- Kingston Library, Fairfield Road, Kingston, during normal opening hours;
- Surbiton Library, Ewell Road, Surbiton during normal opening hours.
