### INTRODUCTION OF "PAY BY PHONE" FACILITY FOR ON-STREET PARKING

#### THE KINGSTON UPON THAMES (PARKING PLACES) (AMENDMENT NO. \*) ORDER 20\*\*

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the Royal Borough of Kingston upon Thames propose to make the above Order under sections 45, 46, 49 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.
2. The general effects of the Order would be to amend certain provisions of the Borough's on-street parking Orders as follows:
  - (a) payment of the parking charge at "pay and display" and "shared use" parking places can be made, where available, using "pay by phone" technology (via connection with the Council's service provider);
  - (b) if only one method of payment of the parking charge is available (i.e. cash or "pay by phone"), that method must be used;
  - (c) the parking charge and maximum parking period, etc, at each parking place where the "pay by phone" payment facility is available will remain unchanged. A service charge (of not more than 20 pence) will be incurred for using the facility.

The "pay by phone" payment facility will initially be available in the following Controlled Parking Zones only; Canbury (B), Grove (G/G1), Riverside (R) & Surbiton (S). User instructions will be displayed at each parking place where the "pay by phone" payment facility is available.

3. The proposed Order and other documents giving more detailed particulars of the Order are available for inspection until 6 weeks have elapsed from the date on which either the Order is made or the Council decides not to make the Order at:
  - The Information and Advice Centre, Guildhall 2, Kingston upon Thames, KT1 1EU between 8.30 a.m. and 5.00 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays inclusive;
  - Hook & Chessington Library, The Hook Centre, Hook Road, Chessington during normal opening hours;
  - Kingston Library, Fairfield Road, Kingston, during normal opening hours;
  - New Malden Library, Sandal Road, New Malden, during normal opening hours;
  - Old Malden Library, Church Road, Worcester Park, during normal opening hours;
  - Surbiton Library, Ewell Road, Surbiton, during normal opening hours;
  - Tolworth Community Library, 37-39 The Broadway, Tolworth, during normal opening hours; and
  - Tudor Drive Library, Tudor Drive, Kingston during normal opening hours.
