RUSHETT LANE, CHESSINGTON**

**THE KINGSTON UPON THAMES (40 MPH SPEED LIMIT) (NO.\*) TRAFFIC ORDER 200\***

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the Royal Borough of Kingston upon Thames propose to make the above-mentioned Order under section 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by the Local Government Act 1985.
2. The general effect of the Order would be to impose a 40 m.p.h. speed limit in Rushett Lane, Chessington and Christ Church Road, Epsom which would lie between a point 156.5 metres west of the boundary with Epsom & Ewell Borough Council and the existing 40 m.p.h. speed limit east of that boundary.
3. The proposed Order and other documents giving more detailed particulars of the Order are available for inspection until 6 weeks have elapsed from the date on which either the Order is made or the Council decides not to make the Order at:
  - The Information and Advice Centre, Guildhall 2, Kingston upon Thames, KT1 1EU between 8.30 a.m. and 5.00 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays inclusive;
  - Hook & Chessington Library, The Hook Centre, Hook Road, Chessington during normal opening hours.
