

ROYAL BOROUGH OF KINGSTON UPON THAMES

SURBITON - MINOR PARKING AMENDMENTS EWELL ROAD, RAEBURN AVENUE & VICTORIA ROAD

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the Royal Borough of Kingston upon Thames propose to make the following Orders under sections 6, 45, 46, 49 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended:

- The Kingston upon Thames (Parking Places) (Riverside) (Amendment No. *) Traffic Order 20**;
 - The Kingston upon Thames (Parking Places) (Surbiton) (No. 3) (Amendment No. *) Traffic Order 20**;
 - The Kingston upon Thames (Free Parking Places) (Goods Vehicles) (Amendment No. **) (Special Parking Area) Traffic Order 20**;
 - The Kingston upon Thames (Waiting And Loading Restriction) (Amendment No. *) Traffic Order 20**.
2. The general effect of the Orders would be;
- in Ewell Road, in conjunction with Surbiton Hospital development works;
 - to replace the single yellow line with double yellow line “at any time” waiting restrictions and to extend the hours of the loading restriction (between Nos. 89 and 97 Ewell Road);
 - to extend the hours of the waiting & loading restrictions (between Nos. 86 and 104 Ewell Road);
 - in Raeburn Avenue, to introduce double yellow line “at any time” waiting restrictions at various locations (on both sides, between Nos. 99 and 109);
 - in Alexandra Drive, to introduce double yellow line “at any time” waiting restrictions at various locations (on both sides, around ‘the triangle’ area);
 - in Victoria Road;
 - to convert existing ‘pay & display’ parking places (outside Nos. 68, 71 & 76) to ‘Variable use’ i.e. for loading/unloading of Goods Vehicles between 7 a.m. & 9 a.m. and for ‘pay & display’ parking between 9 a.m. & 6.30 p.m. (Mondays to Saturdays);
 - to remove the part of the existing ‘pay & display’ parking place outside Nos. 78-79 (due to relocated bus stop);
 - to remove a 10 metre length of the “at any time” loading restriction (outside Nos. 83 & 84);
 - for the purpose of allowing access to off-street parking areas, to;
 - remove part of the Permit Holder parking place at No. 29 Balaclava Road;
 - remove the Permit Holder parking place outside No. 47 Westfield Road.

3. The proposed Orders, and other documents giving more detailed particulars of the Orders, including plans showing their location and effect, are available for inspection until 6 weeks have elapsed from the date on which either the Orders are made or the Council decides not to make the Orders at:

- The Information and Advice Centre, Guildhall 2, Kingston upon Thames, KT1 1EU between 8.30 a.m. and 5.00 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays inclusive;
- Surbiton Library, Ewell Road, Surbiton during normal opening hours.
