PROPOSED WAITING RESTRICTIONS CHESSINGTON, NEW MALDEN, SURBITON & WORCESTER PARK

THE KINGSTON UPON THAMES (WAITING AND LOADING RESTRICTION) (AMENDMENT NO.*) TRAFFIC ORDER 20**

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the Royal Borough of Kingston upon Thames propose to make the above Order under sections 6 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.

2. The general effects of the Order would be;

- to introduce additional “at any time” double yellow line waiting restrictions in Fullers Way South, Glen Road, Hunters Road, Priory Road and Willcocks Close, Chessington;
- to introduce additional “at any time” double yellow line waiting restrictions in Elm Road, New Malden. To shorten lengths of single yellow line waiting restrictions in Beresford Road and Dunbar Road, New Malden;
- to formalise the restricted hours for the single yellow line waiting restriction between Nos. 226 & 248 Kingston Road, New Malden;
- to introduce additional “at any time” double yellow line waiting restrictions in Herne Road, Surbiton;
- to introduce additional “at any time” double yellow line waiting restrictions in Caverleigh Way and Pembury Avenue, Worcester Park. To convert single yellow line waiting restrictions to “at any time” double yellow line waiting restrictions in Forest Side, Fullbrooks Avenue and Malden Road, Worcester Park.

3. The Order, and other documents giving more detailed particulars of the Order, including plans showing the location and effect of the proposed restrictions, are available for inspection until 6 weeks have elapsed from the date on which either the Order is made or the Council decides not to make the Order at:

- The Information and Advice Centre, Guildhall 2, Kingston upon Thames, KT1 1EU between 8.30 a.m. and 5.00 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays inclusive;
- Hook & Chessington Library, Hook Road, Chessington during normal opening hours;
- New Malden Library, Kingston Road, New Malden during normal opening hours;
- Old Malden Library, Church Road, Worcester Park during normal opening hours; and
- Surbiton Library, 21-23 Ewell Road, Surbiton during normal opening hours.
