PROPOSED WAITING RESTRICTIONS MALDENS & COOMBE

THE KINGSTON UPON THAMES (WAITING AND LOADING RESTRICTION) (AMENDMENT NO.*) TRAFFIC ORDER 20**

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the Royal Borough of Kingston upon Thames propose to make the above Order under sections 6 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.

2. The general effects of the Order would be to introduce additional “at any time” double yellow line waiting restrictions at various locations in the following roads;

- New Malden -** Alverstone Road, Beverley Road, Blagdon Road, Duke’s Avenue, Elm Road, Howard Road, King’s Avenue, Langley Grove, Malden Hill, Malden Hill Gardens, Onslow Road & Traps Lane;
- Worcester Park -** Park Terrace (outside The Worcester Park public house & Briarwood Court);
- Kingston -** Eastbury Road (at the side of No. 109 Richmond Road).

3. The proposed Order and other documents giving more detailed particulars of the Order are available for inspection until 6 weeks have elapsed from the date on which either the Order is made or the Council decides not to make the Order at:

- The Information and Advice Centre, Guildhall 2, Kingston upon Thames, KT1 1EU between 8.30 a.m. and 5.00 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays inclusive;
- Kingston Library, Fairfield Road, Kingston, during normal opening hours;
- New Malden Library, Sandal Road, New Malden, during normal opening hours;
- Old Malden Library, Church Road, Worcester Park, during normal opening hours.
