Expressions of Interest are invited from suitably experienced consultants to undertake a Strategic Flood Risk Assessment (SFRA) covering the local authorities of Kingston upon Thames, Richmond upon Thames and Elmbridge. The SFRA should be developed in accordance with the emerging Planning Policy Guidance note 25 (PPS25): Development and Flood Risk. The SFRA will be a strategic investigation that reviews flood risk throughout the local planning authorities and informs planning decisions including the allocation of land for future development and/or regeneration and the development of planning policy that will put into place safeguards to ensure future sustainability. The outputs of the study will inform the Local Development Frameworks, including the Sustainability Appraisals of the above local authorities.

The successful consultancy will be expected to commence the study without delay and complete the assessment by the end of September 2006.
