Enlargement of school premises at St Matthew's Church of England Primary School

Notice is given in accordance with section 19(1) of the Education and Inspections Act 2006 that the Royal Borough of Kingston upon Thames and the Governing body of St Matthew's Church of England Primary School intends to make a prescribed alteration to St Matthew's Church of England Primary School, Langley Road, Surbiton, KT6 6LW from 1 September 2011.

The Local Authority intends to increase the capacity of St Matthew's C of E Primary School by 105 places in order to provide the physical capacity for an additional half form of entry to be accommodated from the start of the 2011/12 academic year.

The current capacity of the school is 315 and the proposed capacity will be 420. The current number of pupils registered at the school is 342. The current admission number for the school is 45 and the proposed admission number will be 60.

Explanatory Notes:

1. Following a substantial rise in the birth rate and subsequent increase in the number of resident children, the Local Authority has embarked upon a strategy to permanently increase the number of primary school places in the Borough.
2. The current roll of 342 at St Matthew's includes an additional 45 Year R places provided over the Published Admission Number in 2009 to temporarily increase the number of places in Year R at the school.
3. Following the determination of this proposal, an application will be made in accordance with section 1.21 of the School Admissions Code to the Office of the Schools Adjudicator for an increase in the school's Published Admission Number for September 2011.
