- 1. This Order shall come into force on 4 October 2021 and may be cited as The Kingston upon Thames (20 mph Speed Limit) (No. 1) Traffic Order 2021.
- 2. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 20 miles per hour on any length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order.
- 3. No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011*(c)* when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.


