Table 2 – Application for designation of a **Neighbourhood Area**

Legal requirements

An application for designation of a Neighbourhood Area must be addressed to the local planning authority. It must consist of the following elements:

a) a map which identifies the area to which the area application relates; Para 1

b) a statement explaining why this area is considered appropriate to be Para 2 designated as a Neighbourhood Area; and

c) a statement that the organisation or body making the area application is a Para 4 relevant body, i.e. an organisation or body which is, or is capable of being, designated as a Neighbourhood Forum (for the corresponding Neighbourhood Area).

RBK requirements

Applicants should also provide:

boundary on an OS base map;

a) the contact details for the main liaison member of the community group, Para 5 including name, email address and phone number;

b) a plan showing the proposed Neighbourhood Area should have a red line \qquad Para 1

c) a statement outlining the reasons why the area selected has been chosen, Para 2 including where the boundaries fall; and

d) a statement outlining the aims, objectives and what a Neighbourhood Plan Para 3 could achieve for this area and reasons.
