- 1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the Royal Borough of Kingston upon Thames on 7 February 2022 made the above mentioned Orders under section sections 6, 45, 46, 49 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by the Local Government Act 1985.
- 2. The general effect of the Orders, which will come into force on 14 March 2022 will be to continue in force indefinitely the provisions of the following Orders:
  - The Kingston upon Thames (Prescribed Routes) (Amendment No. 19) Experimental Order 2020; The Kingston upon Thames (Prescribed Routes) (Amendment No. 20) Experimental Order 2020
  - The Kingston upon Thames (Prescribed Routes) (Amendment No. 21) Experimental Order 2020
- 3. The effect of the Orders is to retain on a permanent basis;
  - (a) a 'Pedestrian and Cyclist Zone' at each of the following locations;
    - (i) in Prince's Road, Arthur Road and Borough Road, Kingston, operating between 8.15 a.m. to 9.30 a.m. and 2.30 p.m. to 3:30 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays (during school term times only);
    - (ii) in Buckland Road, Chessington, operating between 8.00 a.m. to 9.30 a.m. and 2.00 p.m. to 3:45 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays (during school term times only);

The following conditions will apply:

- during the operational hours of a scheme, entry to the zone for motor vehicles will be permitted by means of special dispensation only; and
- special dispensation (for entering the zone) will be granted by the Council to residents and businesses within the affected area (as well as to Blue Badge holders who register).
- (b) a system of one-way working for vehicles in Prince's Road (north-eastbound only), Arthur Road (south-eastbound only) and Borough Road (south-westbound only), Kingston.
- (c) a 'Pedestrian and Cyclist Zone' in Alexandra Road and Cherrywood Close, Kingston, operating between 8.15 a.m. to 9.30 a.m. and 2.30 p.m. to 3:30 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays (during school term times only);

The following conditions will apply;

- during the operational hours of a scheme, entry to the zone for motor vehicles will be permitted by means of special dispensation only; and
- special dispensation (for entering the zone) will be granted by the Council to residents and businesses within the affected area (as well as to Blue Badge holders who register).
