STATEMENT OF REASONS

An existing disabled persons' parking place is now redundant and would be removed.

In Aragon Road, Kingston, proposed double yellow line "at any time" waiting restrictions are intended to enhance visibility at the junction for traffic turning from Aragon Road into Tudor Drive.

At the north-eastern junction between Coutts Avenue and Sanger Avenue, Chessington, double yellow line "at any time" waiting restrictions are introduced to maintain sightlines at the junction for traffic exiting Coutts Ave & prevent obstruction of the junction

In The Keep, Kingston, proposed double yellow line "at any time" waiting restrictions are intended to prevent obstructive parking.

In South Lane, New Malden, waiting restrictions are intended to prevent vehicles parking on proposed speed reducing tables.

In Bridge Road and Moor Lane, Chessington, new 'at any time' waiting restrictions are intended to improve intervisibility at Bridge Road / Moor Lane junctions, to remove vehicle obstruction on Moor Lane minor arm and Moor Lane major arm (opposite Church Lane) and to improve lane merging on the westbound exit from the mini-roundabout on Bridge Road.

In Oakcroft Road and Oakcroft Villas, existing restrictions are altered so as to reinforce rules 242 & 243 of the Highway Code with the aim of further protecting safety and access for all road users by highlighting, and enforcing, locations where a vehicle or trailer may otherwise be parked in a dangerous position or cause an unnecessary obstruction of the road.

In Red Lion Road, Surbiton, waiting restrictions are altered or introduced so as to enforce rules 242 & 243 of the Highway Code with the aim of further protecting safety and access for all road users by highlighting, and enforcing, locations where a vehicle or trailer, may otherwise be parked in a dangerous position or cause an unnecessary obstruction of the road.

In Brighton Road, Surbiton, a single yellow line waiting restriction is converted to a double yellow line "at any time" waiting restriction in order to prevent blocking access to car park.

In Gloucester Road, Kingston, existing parking bays are converted from 'permit holders only' to 'pay & display' usage in order to improve parking facilities for customers at local shops.

Additional addresses (for those who may apply for a parking permit for use within the 'Browns Road' Permit Parking Area, DG) would improve parking facilities for residents.
