TOLWORTH AREA 7.5 TONNE LORRY BAN

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the Royal Borough of Kingston upon Thames propose to make the following Order **The Kingston upon Thames (Prescribed Route) (No. *) Traffic Order 202*** under sections 6 and 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by the Local Government Act 1985:
2. The general effect of the Order would be to prohibit goods vehicles, the maximum gross weight of which exceeds 7.5 tonnes from entering or proceeding except for loading or unloading or the purpose of gaining access in all those streets and lengths of streets which lie within the area partly bounded by but not including:- Ditton Road, Ewell Road, Tolworth Broadway, Hook Rise North and Hook Road, also including St Matthews Avenue.

Statement of Reasons

The 7.5 tonnes weight restriction will remove heavy goods vehicles from travelling through the area making the residential roads safer for all users.

The Council of the Royal Borough of Kingston upon Thames, after consulting the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 6 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**(a)** as amended by the Local Government Act 1985**(b)**, and of all other powers thereunto enabling, hereby make the following Order: -

1. This Order shall come into force on * 202* and may be cited as The Kingston upon Thames (Prescribed Route) (No. *) Traffic Order 202*.

2. In this Order:

“goods vehicle” and “maximum gross weight” have the same meanings as in the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016**(c)**; and

“electronic communications network” has the same meaning as in the Communications Act 2003**(d)**

3. No person shall cause any goods vehicle, the maximum gross weight of which exceeds 7.5 tonnes, to enter or proceed in all those streets and lengths of streets which lie within the area partly bounded by but not including:- Ditton Road, Ewell Road, Tolworth Broadway, Hook Rise North and Hook Road, also including St Matthews Avenue.

4. Nothing in Article 3 of this Order shall:

- (a) prevent any person from causing any vehicle to enter any prescribed street for the purpose of loading or unloading in any prescribed street or for the purpose of gaining access to off-street garaging accessible only from any prescribed street;

- (b) apply in relation to any vehicle when used in the service of a local authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties provided that in all circumstances it is reasonably necessary in the exercise of such powers or in the performance of such duties for that vehicle to enter any prescribed street; or
- (c) apply in relation to any vehicle being used in connection with the maintenance, improvement, reconstruction, cleansing or lighting of any prescribed street, or the laying, erection, alteration or repair of any sewer thereunder or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any electronic communication network thereunder or thereon, or the placing, maintenance or removal of any traffic sign thereon; or
- (d) apply to anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform; or
- (e) apply to any person who causes any vehicle to proceed in accordance with any restriction or requirement indicated by traffic signs placed pursuant to section 66 or section 67 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984; or
- (f) apply in relation to any vehicle being used for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes in an emergency.

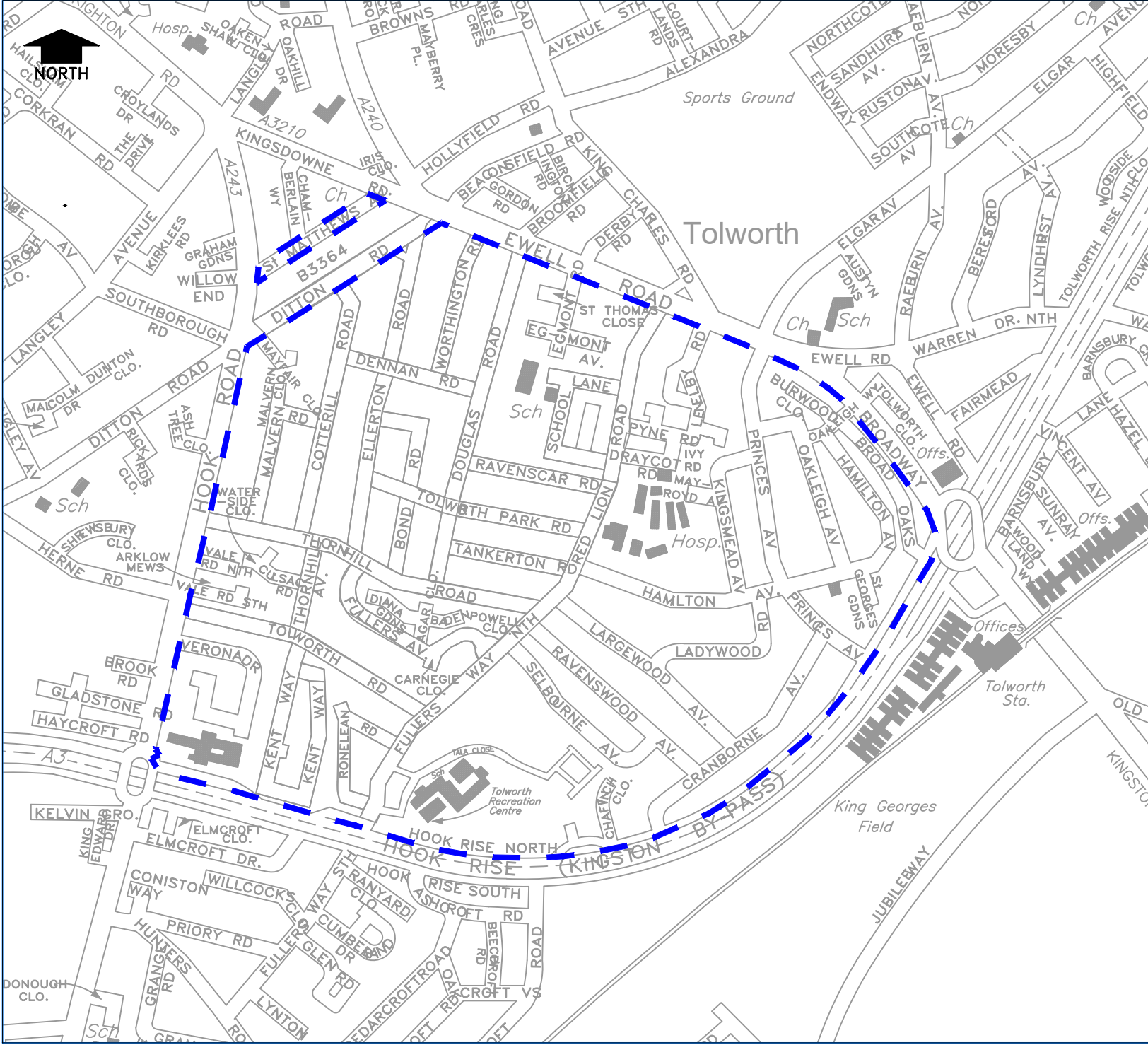

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

This Order prohibits good vehicles, the maximum gross weight of which exceeds 7.5 tonnes from entering or proceeding except for loading or unloading or the purpose of gaining access in all those streets and lengths of streets which lie within the area partly bounded by but not including: Ditton Road, Ewell Road, Tolworth Broadway, Hook Rise North and Hook Road, also including St Matthews Avenue.
