## Your rights



- You have the right to receive support such as:
  - Health care
  - Education (children **must** be educated)
  - Public funds
  - Integration support - please contact your council



- There are laws to protect you when you are working; you have rights as an employee.



- You are entitled to:
  - a minimum wage
  - to receive paid holiday
  - not to be overworked.



- You have the right:
  - to liberty
  - to freedom of thought
  - to marry

## Your responsibilities



- You are expected to stick to a set of core values and responsibilities.



- These core values include to:
  - Respect and obey the law
  - Respect the rights and opinions of others
  - Treat others with fairness
