Part I – Modification of Definitive Map Description of the public path The effect of the order is to upgrade to Restricted Byway status public footpath No 24 which varies in width between approximately 5.5 metres and 16.7 metres and 585 metres in length in Green Lane Chessington to Chalky Lane Chessington and in the position shown by a broken green line on the map attached to this Order and as described in Part II below

## Part II - Modification of Definitive Statement

The entry for Public Footpath 24 on the Definitive Map and Statement is amended by the deletion of Public Footpath and its substitution by Restricted Byway for its length varying in width between 5.5 metres and 16.7 metres (as shown enclosed on the 1:2500 OS County Series Maps Surrey XII.16 and XVIII.4 (1913 Editions)) and 585 metres in length in the position shown by a broken green line on the map attached to this Order:
