






Be aware that anti-vaccine stories are often spread online throughout social media. These stories may not be based on real facts.

	The vaccine was made by people working together, all over the world. They spent a lot of money on making the vaccine so it could be made much quicker than usual.

	No. The covid 19 vaccine is always free. The NHS will never ask for your money or for your bank details to confirm who you are

	4. DOES THE VACCINE HAVE ANY ANIMAL PARTS?

	5. DOES IT HAVE ANY SIDE EFFECTS?
