# EXPERIMENTAL CYCLE FACILITIES WITH WAITING AND LOADING AMENDMENTS – CAMBRIDGE ROAD, KINGSTON (REF. KINGMAP0053)

The Kingston upon Thames (Free Parking Places, Loading Places and Waiting, Loading and Stopping Restrictions) (Amendment No. 47) Experimental Order 2021; The Kingston upon Thames (Charged-For Parking Places) (Amendment No. 47) Experimental Order 2021; The Kingston upon Thames (Prescribed Routes) (No. 3) Experimental Order 2021; and The Kingston upon Thames (Bus Priority) (Amendment No. 7) Experimental Traffic Order 2021.

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the Royal Borough of Kingston upon Thames on 26<sup>th</sup> July 2021 made the above-mentioned Orders under section 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by the Local Government Act 1985.

2. The general effect of the Orders, which will come into force on 9<sup>th</sup> August 2021, are such that, on an experimental basis, in Cambridge Road, Kingston, due to the introduction of cycle facilities;

- (a) to introduce a mandatory, two-way cycle lane which will operate at any time;
  - (i) on the north-east side, from approximately 25 metres south of its junction with London Road to Nos. 1 to 7 Vicarage House; and
  - (ii) on the north side, from the eastern boundary of Vicarage House to No. 11 Cambridge Road;
- (b) to introduce double yellow line "at any time" waiting restrictions and "at any time" loading restrictions (in place of existing waiting and loading restrictions);
  - (i) on the east side, between its junction with London Road and Nos. 1 to 7 Vicarage House;
  - (ii) on the north side, between Nos. 7 and 11 Cambridge Road;
  - (iii) on the south side, at the western boundary of St. Peter's House;
- (c) to alter the operational times of an existing loading restriction (on the south-west side, between its junctions with Church Road and Victoria Road), to apply on Mondays to Saturdays between 7 a.m. and 10 a.m. and between 4 p.m. and 7 p.m.;
- (d) to alter lengths of existing waiting and loading restrictions due to the introduction of a pedestrian crossing and relocation of bus stops (between its junctions with Victoria Road and Rayleigh Court); and
- (e) to remove existing bus lanes in Cambridge Road (eastbound, between Vicarage House and its junction with Rayleigh Court; and westbound, between No. 34 and St. Peter's House).

3. The Orders provide that, subject to the provisions of section 10 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the Council's Director of Corporate and Communities, or some person authorised in that behalf by them, may, if it appears to them or that person essential in the interest of the expeditious, convenient and safe movement of traffic or for providing suitable and adequate parking facilities on the highway or for preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which any road affected by the Orders runs, modify or suspend the Orders or any provision contained therein.

4. Due to the current Coronavirus pandemic, the experimental Orders and plans cannot currently be inspected at Guildhall 2 until the building is open again for normal business. However, the following alternative arrangements have been made;

- a) the made Orders and plans can be inspected online at www.kingston.gov.uk/unmade-traffic-management-orders;
- b) the made Orders and plans can be inspected at Council libraries which have reopened on a temporarily limited basis; and

5. Any person desiring to question the validity of the Orders or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the relevant powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or that any relevant requirements thereof or any relevant regulations made thereunder have not been complied with in relation to the Orders may, within six weeks from the date on which the Orders were made, make application for the purpose to the High Court.

6. The Council will be considering in due course whether the provisions of the experimental Orders should be continued in force indefinitely by means of Orders made under sections 6, 45, 46, 49 and 124 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. Any person may object to the making of an Order for the purpose of such indefinite continuation within a period of six months beginning from the date on which the experimental Order came into force, or if an experimental Order is varied or modified, beginning with the date on which such variation or modification came into force. # STATEMENT OF REASONS

This is the first stage of the Council's construction of a cycleway between Kingston and New Malden. The innovative measures being introduced, to the latest cycling standards, require an experimental approach as adaptations/modifications may be necessary during the experimental period.

- 1. This Order shall come into force on 9<sup>th</sup> August 2021 and may be cited as the Kingston upon Thames (Prescribed Routes) (No. 3) Experimental Traffic Order 2021.
- 2. In this Order:

"cycle lane" means any area of carriageway specified in columns 2 and 3 of the Schedule to this Order which is bounded by a continuous white line on its southeast side and has signs marked thereon of the size, type and colour as specified in the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016*(b)*;

"enactment" means any enactment, whether public general or local, and includes any order, byelaw, rule, regulation, scheme or other instrument having effect by virtue of an enactment;

"pedal cycle" has the same meaning as in the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016(*b*).

(2) Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment.

3. Except as provided in Article 4 of this Order, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle other than a pedal cycle to enter or proceed in the cycle lane otherwise than for the purpose of crossing it.

- 4. Nothing in Article 3 of this Order shall apply to:-
  - (a) a vehicle being used for ambulance, fire brigade or police purposes;
  - (b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform;
  - (c) any person who causes or permits any vehicle to proceed in accordance with any restriction or requirement indicated by traffic signs placed pursuant to section 66 or 67 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984;
  - (d) in any case where the person in control of the vehicle is required by law to stop in the cycle lane or is obliged to do so in order to avoid an accident and as soon as reasonably practical thereafter causes that vehicle to leave the cycle lane;
  - (e) a vehicle being used in connection with the removal of any obstruction in the cycle lane providing that in all circumstances it is reasonably necessary for the vehicle to enter the cycle lane;
  - (f) a vehicle being used in the service of a local authority for the purpose of exercising any statutory powers or performing any statutory duties in the cycle lane, a vehicle being used in connection with any building operation, demolition or excavation in or adjacent to the cycle lane, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the highway in or adjacent to the cycle lane, the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or adjacent to the cycle lane of any sewer, main pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telecommunications apparatus, or the placing, maintenance or removal of any traffic sign, provided that in all the circumstances it is reasonably necessary for the vehicle to enter the cycle lane;
  - (g) (i) a vehicle while postal packets addressed to premises adjacent to the cycle lane are being unloaded from that vehicle or, having been unloaded therefrom, are being delivered; or
    - (ii) while postal packets are being collected for loading on that vehicle from premises or posting boxes adjacent to the cycle lane or, having been collected, are being loaded thereon.
- 5. In pursuance of section 10(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the Service Director (Planning and Transportation) of the Council of the Royal Borough of Kingston upon Thames, or some person authorised by him, may, if it appears essential in the interests of the expeditious, convenient and safe movement of traffic, or of the provision of suitable and adequate parking facilities on the highway, or for improving the amenities of the area through which any road affected by this Order runs, and after consulting the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis, modify or suspend any provision of this Order.






