STATEMENT OF REASONS

The introduction of a disabled persons' parking place is intended to provide on-street parking facilities for mobility-impaired residents to enable them to park close to their homes.

In Knightwood Crescent, New Malden, the introduction of a double yellow line "at any time" waiting restriction is intended to reinforce rules 242 & 243 of the Highway Code with the aim of further protecting safety and access for all road users by highlighting, and enforcing, locations where a vehicle or trailer may otherwise be parked in a dangerous position or cause an unnecessary obstruction of the road. This restriction is introduced in response to a petition from local residents.


