- Speak to your caseworker to sign up for a course called We are Digital. It is a 6 hour online course.

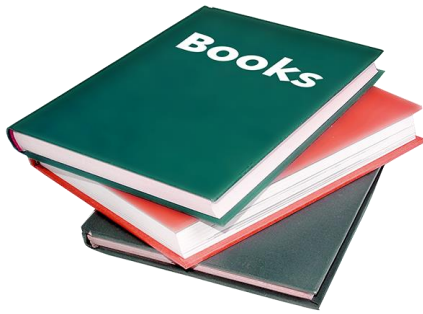


Learn how to do some of these things:

- You can register at your local library: [Register with any of the 7 Libraries in the borough for free](#)



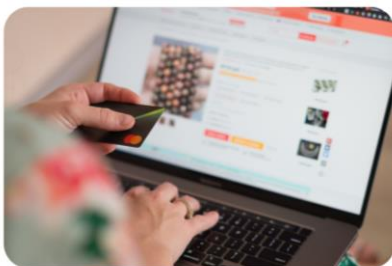
You can join your local library and do some of these things:

- Get a library card

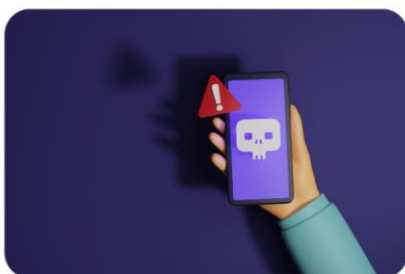
## Online safety
