## In an emergency:

- fire
- serious health problems
- police

Dial 999 on your phone.



 You can ask for an interpreter to help with talking to an emergency worker on the phone.



• If you find a fire, you should ask for the **fire service**.



 If you see a crime or you are worried for your's or someone else's safety, you should ask for the police.



• If someone has a health emergency you should ask for an **ambulance**.



• The Accident & Emergency (A&E) department is always open to help you if you are ill or injured.
