

Neighbourhood Area Designation Notice

Section 61G of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 (as inserted by Schedule 9 Part 1 of the Localism Act (2011)) provides a local planning authority the power to designate an area as a neighbourhood area. Under The Neighbourhood Planning (General) Regulations 2012 Part 2 Regulation 7 a local planning authority must publish on their website, and in such other manner as they consider is likely to bring the designation to the attention of people who live, work or carry on business in the neighbourhood area; the name of the neighbourhood area a map which identifies the area; and the name of the relevant body who applied for the designation.

Notice is hereby given that the Royal Borough of Kingston upon Thames, through a decision made on 30th March 2017 by the Director of Place, has designated the North Kingston Neighbourhood Area as applied for. The boundary of the area is shown edged red on the map below.



Reasons for Decision

The North Kingston Neighbourhood Area covers an appropriately sized geographic area with clearly defined boundaries that complies with national planning policy guidance and is therefore considered acceptable for the purposes of planning at the neighbourhood level.
